- AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTERS TO DIRECT,
- 2 CONTROL OR REGULATE TRAFFIC WHILE ACTUALLY ENGAGED IN THE

- 5 RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** A volunteer fire fighter registered with the
- 8 State of Mississippi or a political subdivision thereof shall be
- 9 authorized to direct, control or regulate traffic while actually
- 10 engaged in the performance of his duties.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 63-3-203, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 12 amended as follows:
- 13 63-3-203. No person shall willfully fail or refuse to comply
- 14 with any lawful order or direction of any police officer or
- 15 <u>volunteer fire fighter</u> invested by law with authority to direct,
- 16 control or regulate traffic.
- SECTION 3. Section 63-3-313, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 18 amended as follows:
- 19 63-3-313. No driver of a vehicle shall disobey the
- 20 instructions of any official traffic-control device placed in
- 21 accordance with the provisions of this chapter, unless at the time
- 22 otherwise directed by a police officer or volunteer fire fighter
- 23 invested by law with authority to direct, control or regulate
- 24 traffic.
- 25 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2002.
