COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2116

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-9-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 PROVIDE FOR THE ALLOCATION OF CERTAIN FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY FUNDS 2 ALLOCATED TO MISSISSIPPI UNDER THE TRANSPORTATION EQUITY ACT FOR THE TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY (TEA-21); TO AMEND SECTION 65-9-30, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR RELATED 3 4 5 6 PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 65-9-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 9 10 65-9-29. (1) Federal aid highway funds allocated to Mississippi * * * to be expended on the federal aid * * * routes 11 shall be expended as follows: 12 Not less than fifty percent (50%) of the funds 13 (a) appropriated to Mississippi allocated for substate distribution in 14 any area of the state under the Surface Transportation Program 15 authorization of Public Law 105-178 (the Transportation Equity Act 16 17 for the Twenty-first Century, hereinafter called TEA-21) and fifty percent (50%) of the amount allocated to areas with a population 18 of less than five thousand (5,000) shall be allocated to the 19 eighty-two (82) counties of the state and administered by the 20 Office of State Aid Road Construction. 21 Not less than thirty percent (30%) of the bridge 22 (b) replacement funds allocated to Mississippi under TEA-21 shall be 23 24 allocated to the eighty-two (82) counties of the state to replace deficient bridges in accordance with all rules and regulations of 25 the Federal Highway Administration and administered by the Office 26 27 of State Aid Road Construction. (c) Such division will be made upon allocation by the 28 Division Administrator of the Federal Highway 29 G1/2 S. B. No. 2116

30 Administration * * *. The expenditure of all federal * * * funds 31 shall be through and under the <u>Mississippi Department of</u> 32 <u>Transportation</u>, subject to and in accordance with all rules and 33 regulations and applicable laws of the federal government. 34 * * *

35 (2) Federal aid * * * highway funds allocated to 36 Mississippi, * * * including federal bridge replacement funds and 37 other special grants made available for expenditure of county 38 roads, shall be expended as follows:

39 (a) Federal aid * * * highway funds expended on state
40 aid roads shall be matched with available state aid funds and/or
41 other available local funds, or as otherwise provided in Section
42 65-1-70, Mississippi Code of 1972.

(b) Federal aid * * * highway funds available for
expenditure on roads not on the state aid system and not eligible
for inclusion on the state aid system shall be matched with
available local funds, or as otherwise provided in Section 65-9-17
or Section 65-1-70, Mississippi Code of 1972.

The expenditure of all federal * * * highway funds 48 (C) 49 on county roads shall be programmed by the State Highway Commission, subject to and in accordance with applicable federal 50 51 law, rules and regulations, and limited to such county projects as recommended by the State Aid Engineer. The State Aid Engineer is 52 authorized to assign state aid personnel to administer off-system 53 construction projects and other special federal aid program 54 requirements in the same manner and under the same provisions and 55 56 conditions as other projects authorized under this chapter.

57 **SECTION 2.** Section 65-9-30, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 58 amended as follows:

59 65-9-30. (1) The State Aid Engineer shall maintain an
60 accurate record of all federal aid <u>highway</u> funds * * * and all
61 other available federal road funds allocated to the
62 counties * * *. He shall likewise maintain an accurate account of

S. B. No. 2116 02/SS02/R187CS PAGE 2 all state aid funds apportioned to the counties in accordance withthe percentages and provisions set out in Section 27-65-75.

The State Aid Engineer is hereby authorized to utilize 65 (2) 66 state aid funds, and federal aid highway funds allocated to the 67 counties as provided for in accordance with Section 65-9-29 * * * and/or any other available federal road funds allocated to 68 Mississippi and to be expended on county roads, and allocated to 69 70 the counties as provided for in accordance with Section 65-9-29, in such amounts as he deems necessary for an orderly and effective 71 programming of all funds available to the counties, including an 72 73 interchange of one (1) type of funds for another type of funds when necessary; provided, however, that each county shall receive, 74 75 not less than annually, its pro rata share of the combined funds so allocated; and further provided that the authority of the 76 77 county boards of supervisors to otherwise adopt construction programs is in no way circumvented. 78

79 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 80 and after July 1, 2002.
