SENATE BILL NO. 2116

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-9-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ALLOCATION AND MATCHING OF FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY
- 3 FUNDS ALLOCATED TO MISSISSIPPI UNDER THE TRANSPORTATION EQUITY ACT
- 4 FOR THE TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY (TEA-21); TO AMEND SECTION 65-9-30,
- MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR RELATED 5
- 6 PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 65-9-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8
- amended as follows: 9
- 10 65-9-29. (1) Federal aid highway funds allocated to
- Mississippi * * * to be expended on the federal aid * * * routes 11
- shall be expended as follows: 12
- (a) * * * Federal aid * * * funds allocated to 13
- Mississippi and to be expended on the federal aid routes shall be 14
- divided between the Mississippi Department of Transportation and 15
- the several counties, so that fifty percent (50%) will be matched 16
- 17 by the Mississippi Department of Transportation and expended on
- the federal aid routes on the state highway system, and fifty 18
- percent (50%) matched by the counties with state aid or local 19
- funds and expended on the federal aid routes in the several 20
- counties. 21
- (b) Such division will be made upon allocation by the 22
- Division Administrator of the Federal Highway Administration. The 23
- expenditure of all federal * * * funds shall be through and under 24
- the Mississippi Department of Transportation, subject to and in 25
- accordance with all rules and regulations and applicable laws of 26
- 27 the federal government.
- (c) Not less than fifty percent (50%) of the funds 2.8
- appropriated to Mississippi allocated for substate distribution in 29

- 30 any area of the state under the Surface Transportation Program
- 31 authorization of Public Law 105-178 (the Transportation Equity Act
- 32 for the Twenty-first Century, hereinafter called TEA-21) and fifty
- 33 percent (50%) of the amount allocated to areas with a population
- 34 of less than five thousand (5,000) shall be allocated to the
- 35 eighty-two (82) counties of the state and administered by the
- 36 Office of State Aid Road Construction.
- 37 (d) Not less than thirty percent (30%) of the bridge
- 38 replacement funds allocated to Mississippi under TEA-21 shall be
- 39 allocated to the eighty-two (82) counties of the state to replace
- 40 deficient bridges in accordance with all rules and regulations of
- 41 the Federal Highway Administration and administered by the Office
- 42 of State Aid Road Construction.

- 44 (2) Federal aid * * * highway funds allocated to
- 45 Mississippi, * * * including federal abridge replacement funds and
- 46 other special grants made available for expenditure of county
- 47 roads, shall be expended as follows:
- 48 (a) Federal aid * * * highway funds expended on state
- 49 aid roads shall be matched with available state aid funds and/or
- 50 other available local funds, or as otherwise provided in Section
- 51 65-1-70, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 52 (b) Federal aid * * * highway funds available for
- 53 expenditure on roads not on the state aid system and not eligible
- 54 for inclusion on the state aid system shall be matched with
- 55 available local funds, or as otherwise provided in Section 65-9-17
- or Section 65-1-70, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 57 (c) The expenditure of all federal * * * highway funds
- 58 on county roads shall be programmed by the State Highway
- 59 Commission, subject to and in accordance with applicable federal
- 60 law, rules and regulations, and limited to such county projects as
- 61 recommended by the State Aid Engineer. The State Aid Engineer is
- 62 authorized to assign state aid personnel to administer off-system

- 63 construction projects and other special federal aid program
- 64 requirements in the same manner and under the same provisions and
- 65 conditions as other projects authorized under this chapter.
- 66 **SECTION 2.** Section 65-9-30, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 67 amended as follows:
- 68 65-9-30. (1) The State Aid Engineer shall maintain an
- 69 accurate record of all federal aid highway funds * * * and all
- 70 other available federal road funds allocated to the
- 71 counties * * *. He shall likewise maintain an accurate account of
- 72 all state aid funds apportioned to the counties in accordance with
- 73 the percentages and provisions set out in Section 27-65-75.
- 74 (2) The State Aid Engineer is hereby authorized to utilize
- 75 state aid funds, and federal aid highway funds allocated to the
- 76 counties as provided for in accordance with Section 65-9-29 * * *
- 77 and/or any other available federal road funds allocated to
- 78 Mississippi and to be expended on county roads, and allocated to
- 79 the counties as provided for in accordance with Section 65-9-29,
- 80 in such amounts as he deems necessary for an orderly and effective
- 81 programming of all funds available to the counties, including an
- 82 interchange of one (1) type of funds for another type of funds
- 83 when necessary; provided, however, that each county shall receive,
- 84 not less than annually, its pro rata share of the combined funds
- 85 so allocated; and further provided that the authority of the
- 86 county boards of supervisors to otherwise adopt construction
- 87 programs is in no way circumvented.
- 88 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 89 and after July 1, 2002.
