SENATE BILL NO. 2133

1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION 2 EQUIPMENT PURCHASE FUND; TO REQUIRE CERTAIN FUNDS TO BE DEPOSITED 3 INTO SUCH FUND; TO AUTHORIZE MONEY IN SUCH FUND TO BE DISBURSED 4 UPON REQUISITIONS SIGNED BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE 5 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; TO AMEND SECTION 6 27-104-27, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND 7 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a 9 10 special fund to be designated as the Mississippi Department of Transportation Equipment Purchase Fund into which shall be 11 deposited such funds as may be appropriated by the Legislature, 12 any funds obtained from the "buy back" option offered by equipment 13 manufacturers or suppliers of certain types of equipment, funds 14 15 obtained from the sale of equipment by the Mississippi Department of Transportation and funds obtained from insurance settlements 16 with regard to equipment utilized by the Mississippi Department of 17 Transportation. Money deposited into the fund shall not lapse at 18 the end of any fiscal year and investment earnings on the proceeds 19 in such special fund shall be deposited into such fund. Money 20 from such fund shall be disbursed therefrom upon warrants issued 21 by the State Fiscal Officer upon requisitions signed by the 22 23 Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Transportation 24 to purchase or lease equipment for the Mississippi Department of 25 Transportation.

26 **SECTION 2.** Section 27-104-27, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 27 amended as follows:

28 27-104-27. Notwithstanding anything in Sections 27-103-101
29 through 27-103-139 and 27-104-1 through 27-104-29 contained, the

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same shall not be construed to apply to any agency supported 30 31 wholly by funds granted or allotted under any act of Congress. The State Auditor of Public Accounts and after July 1, 1986, the 32 33 State Fiscal Officer shall determine which special fund accounts 34 in the State Treasury require an appropriation act and request an 35 appropriation for such special fund accounts. For all other special fund accounts, the State Auditor of Public Accounts, or 36 the State Fiscal Officer after July 1, 1986, shall certify that 37 such accounts do not require an appropriation. The Legislative 38 39 Budget Office shall recommend an appropriation for each special 40 fund account existing in the State Treasury so certified as requiring an appropriation, unless exempted as hereinafter 41 provided. In the event the Legislative Budget Committee and the 42 State Fiscal Officer find that any state agency should not be 43 included under the provisions of Sections 27-103-101 through 44 27-103-139 and 27-104-1 through 27-104-29, then the said committee 45 and officer may, in their discretion, exempt said state agency 46 47 from the provisions thereof. Sections 27-103-101 through 27-103-139 and 27-104-1 through 27-104-29 shall not apply to funds 48 49 collected and disbursed by a state agency created and existing under the provisions of Sections 73-3-101 through 73-3-169. 50 51 Sections 27-103-101 through 27-103-139 and 27-104-1 through 27-104-29 shall not apply to funds deposited into the special fund 52 created pursuant to Section 45-9-101, the special fund created 53 pursuant to Section 69-37-39, the special fund created pursuant to 54 Section 1 of Chapter 521, Laws of 1999, the special fund created 55 56 pursuant to Section 31-17-127 or the special fund created pursuant to Section 1 of Senate Bill No. 2133, 2002 Regular Session. 57 The State Fiscal Officer shall not promulgate or attempt to 58 enforce any rule, order or regulation which is not in accordance 59 60 with the provisions of a legally executed trust indenture

61 agreement, nor shall Sections 27-103-101 through 27-103-139 and

62 27-104-1 through 27-104-29 be construed to apply to funds

65 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 66 and after July 1, 2002.
