SENATE BILL NO. 2176

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-1-2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXEMPT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FROM STATE 1 2 PERSONNEL BOARD PROCEDURES FROM JULY 1, 2002, TO JULY 1, 2003; AND 3 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 65-1-2, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 65-1-2. (1) There is hereby created the Mississippi 8 9 Department of Transportation, which shall include the following 10 offices: (a) Office of Administrative Services. 11 Office of Highways. (b) 12 Office of State Aid Road Construction. 13 (C) Office of Intermodal Planning. (d) 14 Office of Enforcement. (e) 15 Each office shall be composed of such bureaus as deemed 16 (2) necessary by the executive director of the department. 17 The department is designated as the single state agency 18 (3) 19 to receive and expend any funds made available by the United States Department of Transportation or any agency of the federal 20 government for transportation purposes and to cooperate with 21 federal, state, interstate and local agencies, organizations and 22 persons performing activities relating to transportation. This 23 subsection shall not apply to motor carrier safety assistance 24 program funds made available by the federal government to the 25 Public Service Commission. 26 (4) The powers, duties and responsibilities of the State 27 Highway Department with respect to the construction and 28 S. 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29 maintenance of the state highway system are transferred to the 30 Mississippi Department of Transportation.

(5) The powers, duties and responsibilities of the
 <u>Mississippi Development Authority</u> with respect to aeronautics are
 transferred to the Mississippi Department of Transportation.

34 (6) The powers, duties and responsibilities of the State Tax
35 Commission with respect to the weighing of motor vehicles along
36 the highways of this state at inspection stations and by means of
37 portable scales are transferred to the Mississippi Department of
38 Transportation.

39 (7) The powers, duties and responsibilities of the
40 <u>Mississippi Development Authority</u> with respect to transportation
41 matters, except with respect to ports, are transferred to the
42 Mississippi Department of Transportation.

(8) The powers, duties and responsibilities of the State Aid
Engineer and the Office of State Aid Road Construction are
transferred to the Mississippi Department of Transportation.

46 (9) All powers, duties and responsibilities of the Public Service Commission with regard to railroads, except rate-making 47 48 authority, are transferred to the Mississippi Department of The Mississippi Transportation Commission may 49 Transportation. 50 perform any act and issue any rule, regulation or order which the commission is permitted to do by the Federal Railroad Safety Act 51 of 1970 (45 USCS et seq.). A copy of any new rule, regulation or 52 53 order passed by the Mississippi Transportation Commission shall be furnished to members of the Transportation Committees of the 54 55 Mississippi House of Representatives and the Mississippi Senate. Individuals, corporations or companies affected by the order, rule 56 or regulation shall be notified in accordance with the Mississippi 57 Administrative Procedures Law. 58

(10) All records, personnel, property and unexpended
balances of appropriations, allocation or other funds of all those
agencies, boards, commissions, departments, offices, bureaus and

The transfer of segregated or special funds shall be made in such a manner that the relation between program and revenue source as provided by law shall be retained.

(11) From and after January 1, 1993, and until January 1, 67 1994, the Mississippi Department of Transportation and the 68 Mississippi Transportation Commission shall be exempt from State 69 Personnel Board procedures for the purpose of the employment, 70 promotion, realignment, demotion, reprimand, suspension, 71 72 termination, reallocation, reassignment, transfer, moving or relocation of personnel of all those agencies, boards, 73 74 commissions, departments, offices, bureaus and divisions whose duties and responsibilities are transferred by Laws, 1992, Chapter 75 496 to the Mississippi Department of Transportation. 76

(12) From and after July 1, 2002, and until July 1, 2003, 77 the Mississippi Department of Transportation and the Mississippi 78 79 Transportation Commission shall be exempt from State Personnel Board procedures for the purpose of the employment, promotion, 80 81 realignment, demotion, reprimand, suspension, termination, reallocation, reassignment, transfer, moving or relocation of 82 83 personnel of all employees of the Mississippi Department of 84 Transportation. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 85

86 and after July 1, 2002.
