1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-15-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PRESCRIBE THE TYPE OF EVIDENCE OF DATE OF BIRTH REQUIRED FOR A CHILD TO ENROLL IN KINDERGARTEN OR GRADE 1; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. Section 37-15-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	37-15-1. The State Board of Education shall prepare and
9	provide necessary forms for keeping permanent records and
10	cumulative folders for each pupil in the public schools of the
11	state. In the permanent record and cumulative folders, the
12	teachers and principals shall keep information concerning the
13	pupil's date of birth, as verified by the documentation authorized
14	in this section, record of attendance, grades and withdrawal from
15	the school, including the date of any expulsion from the school
16	system and a description of the student's act or behavior
17	resulting in the expulsion. The records also shall contain
18	information pertaining to immunization and such other information
19	as the State Board of Education may prescribe. The cumulative
20	folder, in addition to that information maintained in the
21	permanent records, also shall contain such other information as
22	the State Board of Education shall prescribe. It shall be the
23	responsibility of the person in charge of each school to enforce
24	the requirement for evidence of the age of each pupil before
25	enrollment. If the first prescribed evidence is not available,
26	the next evidence obtainable in the order set forth below shall be
27	accepted:

29	(b) A duly attested transcript of a certificate of
30	baptism showing the date of birth and place of baptism of the
31	child, accompanied by an affidavit sworn to by a parent,
32	grandparent or custodian;
33	(c) An insurance policy on the child's life which has
34	been in force for at least two (2) years;
35	(d) A bona fide contemporary Bible record of the
36	child's birth accompanied by an affidavit sworn to by the parent,
37	grandparent or custodian;
38	(e) A passport or certificate of arrival in the United
39	States showing the age of the child;
40	(f) A transcript of record of age shown in the child's
41	school record of at least four (4) years prior to application,
42	stating date of birth; or
43	(g) If none of these evidences can be produced, an
44	affidavit of age sworn to by a parent, grandparent or custodian.
45	Any child enrolling in Kindergarten or Grade 1 shall present $\underline{\text{the}}$
46	required evidence of age upon enrollment. Any child in Grades 2
47	through 12 not in compliance at the end of sixty (60) days from
48	the opening of the fall term shall be suspended until in
49	compliance.
50	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2002.
