SENATE BILL NO. 2225 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-15-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PRESCRIBE THE TYPE OF EVIDENCE OF DATE OF BIRTH REQUIRED FOR A 3 CHILD TO ENROLL IN KINDERGARTEN OR GRADE 1; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 37-15-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

37-15-1. The State Board of Education shall prepare and 8 9 provide necessary forms for keeping permanent records and cumulative folders for each pupil in the public schools of the 10 state. In the permanent record and cumulative folders, the 11 teachers and principals shall keep information concerning the 12 13 pupil's date of birth, as verified by the documentation authorized in this section, record of attendance, grades and withdrawal from 14 the school, including the date of any expulsion from the school 15 system and a description of the student's act or behavior 16 17 resulting in the expulsion. The records also shall contain information pertaining to immunization and such other information 18 as the State Board of Education may prescribe. The cumulative 19 folder, in addition to that information maintained in the 20 permanent records, also shall contain such other information as 21 the State Board of Education shall prescribe. It shall be the 22 responsibility of the person in charge of each school to enforce 23 the requirement for evidence of the age of each pupil before 24 enrollment. If the first prescribed evidence is not available, 25 the next evidence obtainable in the order set forth below shall be 26 27 accepted:

(a) A certified birth certificate;

29	(b) A duly attested transcript of a certificate of
30	baptism showing the date of birth and place of baptism of the
31	child, accompanied by an affidavit sworn to by a parent,
32	grandparent or custodian;
33	(c) An insurance policy on the child's life which has
34	been in force for at least two (2) years;
35	(d) A bona fide contemporary Bible record of the
36	child's birth accompanied by an affidavit sworn to by the parent,
37	grandparent or custodian;
38	(e) A passport or certificate of arrival in the United
39	States showing the age of the child;
40	(f) A transcript of record of age shown in the child's
41	school record of at least four (4) years prior to application,
42	stating date of birth; or
43	(g) If none of these evidences can be produced, an
44	affidavit of age sworn to by a parent, grandparent or custodian.
45	Any child enrolling in Kindergarten or Grade 1 shall present <u>the</u>
46	required evidence of age upon enrollment. Any child in Grades 2
47	through 12 not in compliance at the end of sixty (60) days from
48	enrollment shall be suspended until in compliance.
49	This section shall stand repealed on July 1, 2003.
50	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
51	and after July 1, 2002.
