- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) The board of supervisors of any county shall
- 6 have the power to establish, alter and change the channels of
- 7 streams or other water courses, and to bridge the same, whenever
- 8 so to do will promote the health, comfort and convenience of the
- 9 inhabitants of such county.
- 10 (2) The board of supervisors of any county shall also have
- 11 the power and authority to incur costs and pay necessary expenses
- 12 in providing labor, materials and supplies to clean or clear
- 13 drainage ditches, creeks or channels, whether on public or private
- 14 property, and to incur costs and pay necessary expenses in
- 15 providing labor, materials and supplies in order to prevent
- 16 erosion where such erosion has been caused or will be caused by
- 17 such drainage ditches, creeks or channels. This section shall not
- 18 impose any obligation or duty upon the county and shall not create
- 19 any additional rights for the benefit of any owner of public or
- 20 private property.
- 21 (3) This section shall stand repealed on July 1, 2004.
- 22 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2002.
