- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 37-7-339, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 8
- 37-7-339. (1) The school board of any local school 9
- district, in its discretion, may provide extended day and extended 10
- school year programs for kindergarten or compulsory-school-age 11
- students, or both, and may expend any funds for these purposes 12
- which are available from nonminimum or nonadequate education 13
- 14 program sources. It is not the intent of the Legislature, in
- enacting this section, to interfere with the Headstart program. 15
- 16 School boards, in their discretion, may charge participants a
- 17 reasonable fee for such programs.
- (2) The school board of any school district may adopt any 18
- orders, policies, rules or regulations with respect to instruction 19
- within that school district for which no specific provision has 20
- 21 been made by general law and which are not inconsistent with the
- 22 Mississippi Constitution of 1890, the Mississippi Code of 1972, or
- 23 any order, policy, rule or regulation of the State Board of
- Education; those school boards also may alter, modify and repeal 24
- any orders, policies, rules or regulations enacted under this 25
- subsection. Any such program pertaining to reading must further 26
- 27 the goal that Mississippi students will demonstrate a growing

- 28 proficiency in reading and will reach or exceed the national
