SENATE BILL NO. 2323

1 AN ACT TO CREATE A STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE IMPROVEMENT 2 OF FREIGHT RAIL SERVICE IN THIS STATE AND THE FEASIBILITY OF HIGH 3 SPEED RAIL SERVICE IN THIS STATE; TO REQUIRE SUCH COMMITTEE TO 4 MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE LEGISLATURE THAT RESULT FROM SUCH 5 COMMITTEE'S STUDY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) There is established a study committee to 8 study the improvement freight rail service in Mississippi and the 9 feasibility of high speed rail service in Mississippi. The study 10 committee shall examine all aspects of freight rail service and 11 high speed rail service and make recommendations regarding such 12 examination to the Legislature on or before December 1, 2002.

The study committee shall be composed of three (3) 13 (2) 14 members appointed by the Governor, three (3) members appointed by the Lieutenant Governor and three (3) members appointed by the 15 Speaker of the House of Representatives. In making their 16 appointments the Governor, Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker of 17 the House of Representatives shall endeavor to achieve a diverse 18 representation, with all geographical areas of the state being 19 represented on the committee. 20

21 (3) Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after 22 passage of this act. Within fifteen (15) days thereafter, on a day to be designated by the Governor, the study committee shall 23 meet and organize by selecting from its membership a chairman and 24 vice chairman. The vice chairman shall serve as secretary and 25 shall be responsible for keeping all records of the study 26 27 committee. A majority of the members of the study committee shall constitute a quorum. In the selection of its officers and the 28

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adoption of rules, resolution and reports, and affirmative vote of a majority of the study committee is required. All members shall be notified in writing of all meetings, and such notices must be mailed at least five (5) days before the date on which a meeting is to be held.

Subject to the availability of funds, for attending 34 (4) meetings of the study committee, members who are not legislators 35 shall be compensated at the per diem rate authorized by Section 36 25-3-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, and shall be reimbursed in 37 accordance with Section 25-3-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, for 38 39 mileage and actual expenses incurred in attending meetings of the committee. If members of the Legislature are appointed to serve 40 41 as members of the study committee, such legislative members shall be paid from the contingent expense fund of their respective house 42 per diem in the same manner as provided for committee meetings 43 when the Legislature is not in session. However, no per diem, 44 45 mileage allowance or expense allowance may be paid for attending 46 meetings of the committee while the Legislature is in session, and no per diem, mileage allowance or expense allowance may be paid 47 without prior approval of the proper committee in the member's 48 respective house. If a state employee is appointed as a member of 49 50 the committee, such state employee shall not be eligible to receive per diem compensation. No study committee member may 51 incur per diem, travel or other expenses unless previously 52 53 authorized by vote at a meeting of the study committee, which action must be recorded in the official minutes of the meeting. 54 55 Nonlegislative members may be paid from any funds made available to the study committee for that purpose. 56

57 (5) The study committee may utilize clerical and legal staff 58 employed by the Mississippi Department of Transportation, the 59 Office of the Governor, the Legislature and any other staff 60 assistance made available to the committee. To effectuate the 61 purpose of this act, any department, division, board, bureau,

No. 2323 02/SS01/R20 PAGE 2 62 commission or agency of the state or of any political subdivision 63 thereof shall at the request of the chairman of the study 64 committee, provide to the study committee such facilities, 65 assistance and data as will enable the special committee to carry 66 out its duties.

67 (6) Funding for the study committee may be provided from any
68 funds that may be appropriated by the Legislature for the expenses
69 of the study committee. The study committee may accept money from
70 ay source, public or private, to be expended in implementing its
71 duties under this act.

(7) Upon presentation of its report to the Legislature
before the 2003 Regular Session, the study committee shall be
dissolved.

75 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 76 and after July 1, 2002.
