1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAG FOR RETIRED PATROLMEN OF THE MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY SAFETY PATROL; TO PROVIDE FOR AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR SUCH TAGS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a
7	retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol and who is
8	a resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge
9	privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
10	prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
11	trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of
12	an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this
13	section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor
14	vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a
15	retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol. The
16	distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and
17	design as the State Tax Commission may prescribe and shall consist
18	of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to
19	distinguish each license tag and may, in the discretion of the
20	State Tax Commission, display the county name.
21	(2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized

by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms

- 24 distinctive license tags shall present proof that they are a
- 25 retired member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol by
- 26 presentation of a signed and notarized affidavit from the
- 27 Commissioner of Public Safety. The application and the additional
- 28 fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less three

- 29 percent (3%) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be
- 30 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as
- 31 prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee
- 32 retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county
- 33 general fund.
- 34 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
- 35 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license
- 36 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
- 37 of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each distinctive license tag applied
- 38 for under this section which shall be in addition to all other
- 39 taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of
- 40 time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag
- 41 year. The additional fee is due and payable at the time the
- 42 original application is made for a distinctive license tag under
- 43 this section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal
- 44 registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license
- 45 tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license
- 46 tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax collector.
- 47 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
- 48 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
- 49 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the
- 50 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of
- 51 distinctive license tags. The State Treasurer shall distribute an
- 52 amount equal to Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the additional fees
- 53 collected for each such distinctive license tag issued under this
- 54 section to the State General Fund, and the remainder of such
- 55 additional fees collected shall be distributed by the State
- 56 Treasurer to the credit of the special fund created in Section
- 57 45-2-1.
- 58 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 59 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 60 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 61 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under

- 62 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 63 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 64 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 65 tag.
- 66 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 67 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 68 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 69 Section 27-19-37, Mississippi Code of 1972. The fee for a
- 70 replacement distinctive license tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00).
- 71 The tax collector receiving such application and affidavit shall
- 72 be entitled to retain and deposit into the county general fund
- 73 five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag and
- 74 the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds
- 75 from the sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under
- 76 this section.
- 77 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 78 and after July 1, 2002.
