SENATE BILL NO. 2368

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-19-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 PROVIDE THAT BEGINNING WITH THE 2002-2003 SCHOOL YEAR, TEACHERS 2 SHALL RECEIVE AN ANNUAL EXPERIENCE INCREMENT FOR UP TO 30 YEARS OF 3 4 TEACHING SERVICE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 37-19-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 37-19-7. (1) This section shall be known and may be cited 8 9 as the Mississippi "Teacher Opportunity Program (TOP)." The allowance in the minimum education program and the Mississippi 10 Adequate Education Program for teachers' salaries in each county 11 and separate school district shall be determined and paid in 12 accordance with the scale for teachers' salaries as provided in 13 this subsection. prescribed above for the 2005-2006 school year to conform to any 103 adjustments made to the salary scale in prior fiscal years due to 104 105 revenue growth over and above five percent (5%). For each one percent (1%) that the Sine Die General Fund Revenue Estimate 106 Growth exceeds five percent (5%) for fiscal year 2006, as 107 certified by the Legislative Budget Office to the State Board of 108 109 Education and subject to specific appropriation therefor by the Legislature, the State Board of Education shall revise the salary 110 scale to provide an additional one percent (1%) across the board 111 112 increase in the base salaries for each type of license.

It is the intent of the Legislature that any state funds made 113 114 available for salaries of licensed personnel in excess of the funds paid for such salaries for the 1986-1987 school year shall 115 116 be paid to licensed personnel pursuant to a personnel appraisal and compensation system implemented by the State Board of 117 Education. The State Board of Education shall have the authority 118 119 to adopt and amend rules and regulations as are necessary to establish, administer and maintain the system. 120

121 All teachers employed on a full-time basis shall be paid a 122 minimum salary in accordance with the above scale. However, no 123 school district shall receive any funds under this section for any 124 school year during which the local supplement paid to any 125 individual teacher shall have been reduced to a sum less than that 126 paid to that individual teacher for performing the same duties 127 from local supplement during the immediately preceding school

For teachers holding a Class AAA license, the minimum base pay specified in this subsection shall be increased by the sum of Six Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$675.00) for each year of teaching experience possessed by the person holding such license until such person shall have <u>thirty (30)</u> years of teaching experience.

For teachers holding a Class AA license, the minimum base pay specified in this subsection shall be increased by the sum of Six Hundred Ten Dollars (\$610.00) for each year of teaching experience possessed by the person holding such license until such person shall have thirty (30) years of teaching experience.

For teachers holding a Class A license, the minimum base pay specified in this subsection shall be increased by the sum of Four Hundred Sixty-five Dollars (\$465.00) for each year of teaching experience possessed by the person holding such license until such person shall have thirty (30) years of teaching experience.

2005-2006 School Year

For teachers holding a Class AAAA license, the minimum base pay specified in this subsection shall be increased by the sum of Seven Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$770.00) for each year of teaching experience possessed by the person holding such license until such person shall have <u>thirty (30)</u> years of teaching experience.

For teachers holding a Class AAA license, the minimum base pay specified in this subsection shall be increased by the sum of Seven Hundred Five Dollars (\$705.00) for each year of teaching experience possessed by the person holding such license until such person shall have <u>thirty (30)</u> years of teaching experience.

For teachers holding a Class AA license, the minimum base pay specified in this subsection shall be increased by the sum of Six Hundred Forty Dollars (\$640.00) for each year of teaching experience possessed by the person holding such license until such person shall have <u>thirty (30)</u> years of teaching experience.

For teachers holding a Class A license, the minimum base pay specified in this subsection shall be increased by the sum of Four Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$480.00) for each year of teaching experience possessed by the person holding such license until such person shall have <u>thirty (30)</u> years of teaching experience.

The level of professional training of each teacher to be used in establishing the salary allotment for the teachers for each year shall be determined by the type of valid teacher's license issued to those teachers on or before October 1 of the current school year.

(2) (a) The following employees shall receive an annual
salary supplement in the amount of Six Thousand Dollars
(\$6,000.00), plus fringe benefits, in addition to any other
compensation to which the employee may be entitled:

250 (i) Any licensed teacher who has met the requirements and acquired a Master Teacher certificate from the 251 National Board for Professional Teaching Standards and who is 252 employed by a local school board or the State Board of Education 253 as a teacher and not as an administrator. Such teacher shall 254 255 submit documentation to the State Department of Education that the certificate was received prior to October 15 in order to be 256 257 eligible for the full salary supplement in the current school 258 year, or the teacher shall submit such documentation to the State

Department of Education prior to February 15 in order to be eligible for a prorated salary supplement beginning with the second term of the school year.

262 (ii) Any licensed school counselor who has met the 263 requirements and acquired a National Certified School Counselor (NCSC) endorsement from the National Board of Certified Counselors 264 265 and who is employed by a local school board or the State Board of 266 Education as a counselor and not as an administrator. Such licensed school counselor shall submit documentation to the State 267 Department of Education that the endorsement was received prior to 268 269 October 15 in order to be eliqible for the full salary supplement in the current school year, or the licensed school counselor shall 270 271 submit such documentation to the State Department of Education prior to February 15 in order to be eligible for a prorated salary 272 supplement beginning with the second term of the school year. 273 274 However, the salary supplement authorized under this item shall be discontinued two (2) years after the date on which the National 275 276 Board for Professional Teaching Standards offers a certification process for a Master Teacher certificate for school counselors, 277 278 and any school counselor receiving the salary supplement will be required to complete the Master Teacher certificate process under 279 280 item (i) of this paragraph in order to continue receiving such 281 salary supplement.

Any licensed speech-language pathologist and 282 (iii) 283 audiologist who has met the requirements and acquired a Certificate of Clinical Competence from the American 284 Speech-Language-Hearing Association and who is employed by a local 285 286 school board. Such licensed speech-language pathologist and 287 audiologist shall submit documentation to the State Department of 288 Education that the certificate or endorsement was received prior to October 15 in order to be eligible for the full salary 289 290 supplement in the current school year, or the licensed speech-language pathologist and audiologist shall submit such 291

documentation to the State Department of Education prior to 292 February 15 in order to be eligible for a prorated salary 293 supplement beginning with the second term of the school year. 294 295 However, the salary supplement authorized under this item shall be 296 discontinued two (2) years after the date on which the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards offers a certification 297 process for a Master Teacher certificate for school 298 299 speech-language pathologists and audiologists, and any school speech-language pathologist and audiologist receiving the salary 300 supplement will be required to complete the Master Teacher 301 302 certificate process under item (i) of this paragraph in order to continue receiving such salary supplement. 303

An employee shall be reimbursed one (1) time for 304 (b) 305 the actual cost of completing the process of acquiring the certificate or endorsement, excluding any costs incurred for 306 postgraduate courses, not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) 307 for a school counselor or speech-language pathologist and 308 309 audiologist, regardless of whether or not the process resulted in 310 the award of the certificate or endorsement. A local school district or any private individual or entity may pay the cost of 311 completing the process of acquiring the certificate or endorsement 312 313 for any employee of the school district described under paragraph (a), and the State Department of Education shall reimburse the 314 school district for such cost, regardless of whether or not the 315 316 process resulted in the award of the certificate or endorsement. If a private individual or entity has paid the cost of completing 317 the process of acquiring the certificate or endorsement for an 318 employee, the local school district may agree to directly 319 320 reimburse the individual or entity for such cost on behalf of the 321 employee.

322 (c) All salary supplements, fringe benefits and process 323 reimbursement authorized under this subsection shall be paid 324 directly by the State Department of Education to the local school

district and shall be in addition to its minimum education program 325 326 allotments and not a part thereof in accordance with regulations promulgated by the State Board of Education, and subject to 327 328 appropriation by the Legislature. Local school districts shall 329 not reduce the local supplement paid to any employee receiving such salary supplement, and the employee shall receive any local 330 supplement to which employees with similar training and experience 331 otherwise are entitled. 332

The State Department of Education may not pay any 333 (d) process reimbursement to a school district for an employee who 334 335 does not complete the certification or endorsement process required to be eligible for the certificate or endorsement. 336 If an employee for whom such cost has been paid in full or in part by a 337 local school district or private individual or entity fails to 338 complete the certification or endorsement process, the employee 339 shall be liable to the school district or individual or entity for 340 all amounts paid by the school district or individual or entity on 341 342 behalf of that employee toward his or her certificate or 343 endorsement.

344 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 345 and after July 1, 2002.
