- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) There is hereby created an Interagency
- 7 Coordinating Council to study and to develop policies relating to
- 8 hepatitis in prisons.
- 9 (2) The council shall consist of one (1) representative from
- 10 each of the following agencies appointed by the executive director
- 11 or commissioner of each agency:
- 12 (a) Department of Corrections;
- 13 (b) Department of Health;
- 14 (c) Office of the Attorney General;
- 15 (d) University Medical Center; and
- 16 (e) Department of Human Services.
- 17 The representative from the Department of Corrections shall
- 18 serve as chairperson of the council.
- 19 (3) (a) The council shall meet at least once each quarter
- 20 on meeting dates set by the council. Each agency that has a
- 21 representative appointed to the council shall ensure that a
- 22 representative of the agency attends at least three (3) quarterly
- 23 meetings of the council each year.
- 24 (b) No member of the council shall receive per diem for
- 25 attending the meetings.
- 26 (4) The council shall:
- 27 (a) Coordinate communication among the member agencies
- 28 concerning each agency's programs in providing hepatitis services:

- 32 (ii) Provision of services to individuals who have

- 34 (5) Not later than September 1 of each even-numbered year,
- 35 the council shall file a report with the Legislature and the
- 36 Governor containing policy recommendations relating to:
- 37 (a) Prevention of hepatitis in prisons;
- 38 (b) Delivery of health services to individuals who have
- 39 hepatitis in prison.
- 40 (6) The council shall establish advisory committees composed
- 41 of representatives from associations, consumer advocates and
- 42 regulatory agencies, boards or commissions as needed to assist in
- 43 carrying out its duties under this section.
- 44 (7) The Department of Corrections shall provide
- 45 administrative support to the council.
- 46 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 47 and after July 1, 2002.
