SENATE BILL NO. 2416 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-33-67, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN LICENSED BINGO OPERATIONS LOCATED WITHIN 3 1500 FEET OF A CHURCH SHALL NOT CONDUCT BINGO SESSIONS DURING 4 CHURCH HOURS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 97-33-67, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

97-33-67. (1) (a) No licensee shall hold, operate or 8 9 conduct any bingo game more often than for two (2) sessions within one (1) day and more often than eight (8) sessions in any one (1) 10 week. Any licensee who holds no more than one (1) session per 11 week shall be entitled to conduct one (1) six-hour session per 12 week. Notwithstanding the provisions of this paragraph, 13 pull-tabs, video pull-tabs or video bingo games may be played for 14 up to eighty (80) hours per week. 15

(b) No licensee shall hold, operate or conduct any
bingo game in more than one (1) physical location. Any bingo
operation for which a license has been issued by the Gaming
Commission on or after April 1, 1995, and which is located within
one thousand five hundred (1,500) feet of a school, church or
public library <u>building</u>, shall not conduct bingo sessions during
the hours of the school day or during church or library hours.

The total amount of prizes which may be awarded in any 23 (2) one (1) session by a licensee shall not exceed Seven Thousand Five 24 Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) in cash or other thing or things of 25 value, except as otherwise provided in Section 97-33-59 and except 26 that the total amount of prizes which may be awarded in any one 27 28 (1) session shall not exceed Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) if S. only one (1) session is held in any one (1) week. The Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) and the Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) limits do not include payback of pull-tabs or electronic representations. The commission shall establish by rule the method of calculating the value of anything offered as a prize.

Each licensee shall designate a supervisor and a 35 (3) sufficient number of alternate supervisors to be in charge of and 36 primarily responsible for each session of a bingo game. 37 Such individual shall be familiar with the provisions of Sections 38 39 97-33-51 through 97-33-203 and the rules and regulations of the commission. Such individual, or alternate who shall be designated 40 41 as the bingo supervisor, shall supervise all activities of such session and be responsible for the conduct of all games of such 42 The supervisor shall be present at all times on the 43 session. premises during the session. 44

(4) No licensee shall purchase or otherwise obtain any gaming supplies or equipment from any distributor, operator or manufacturer until it has first determined that the individual selling or otherwise offering such supplies or equipment has a valid license issued by the commission.

50 (5) No licensee shall allow any person under eighteen (18) years of age to assist in the holding, operation or conduct of any 51 No licensee shall allow any person under eighteen 52 bingo game. 53 (18) years of age to play a bingo game unless accompanied by his or her parent or legal guardian, except that a licensee may 54 55 prohibit all persons under eighteen (18) years from entering the licensed premises by posting a written notice to that effect on 56 57 the premises.

58 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 59 and after its passage.
