SENATE BILL NO. 2418
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTION 73-6-26, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL FOR PERSONS TO CLAIM THAT THEY PERFORM
3 CHIROPRACTIC ADJUSTMENTS/MANIPULATION TO THE ARTICULATIONS OF THE
4 HUMAN SPINE WITHOUT A VALID LICENSE TO PRACTICE CHIROPRACTIC; AND
5 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section
8 73-6-26, Mississippi Code of 1972:

9 73-6-26. It shall be unlawful for any person, corporation or
10 association to, in any manner, make claim, verbally, in writing,
11 or by way of advertising, that they perform chiropractic
12 adjustments/manipulation to the articulations of the human spine
13 unless they hold a valid license to practice chiropractic (D.C.)
14 in the State of Mississippi.

15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
16 and after July 1, 2002.
