5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section

- 7 99-19-18, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 8 99-19-18. When any person is convicted of a felony or
- 9 felonies in which public funds in the amount of Ten Thousand
- 10 Dollars (\$10,000.00) or more were unlawfully taken, obtained or
- 11 misappropriated, the sentence imposed by the court shall include a
- 12 minimum term of imprisonment of one (1) year in the custody of the
- 13 Department of Corrections. Notwithstanding any other law to the
- 14 contrary, such mandatory minimum term shall not be reduced or
- 15 suspended nor shall such person be eligible for probation or
- 16 parole before the expiration of one (1) year of incarceration.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2002.
