SENATE BILL NO. 2450

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 43-13-407 AND 43-13-405, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DIRECT THE STATE TREASURER TO TRANSFER \$3 MILLION
- 3 OF THE 2002 TOBACCO SETTLEMENT INSTALLMENT PAYMENT, AND ANNUALLY
- 4 THEREAFTER, INTO THE HEALTH CARE EXPENDABLE FUND TO BE
- 5 APPROPRIATED FOR THE MISSISSIPPI MEDICAID ASSISTANCE PROGRAM TO
- 6 PROVIDE CARE EXCLUSIVELY TO PATIENTS WITH ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE; AND
- 7 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 43-13-407, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 11 43-13-407. (1) In accordance with the purposes of this
- 12 article, there is established in the State Treasury the Health
- 13 Care Expendable Fund, into which shall be transferred from the
- 14 Health Care Trust Fund the following sums:
- 15 (a) In fiscal year 2000, Fifty Million Dollars
- 16 (\$50,000,000.00);
- 17 (b) In fiscal year 2001, Fifty-five Million Dollars
- 18 (\$55,000,000.00);
- 19 (c) In fiscal year 2002, Sixty Million Five Hundred
- 20 Thousand Dollars (\$60,500,000.00);
- 21 (d) In fiscal year 2003, Sixty-six Million Five Hundred
- 22 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$66,550,000.00);
- (e) In fiscal year 2004 and each subsequent fiscal
- 24 year, a sum equal to the average annual amount of the income from
- 25 the investment of the funds in the Health Care Trust Fund since
- 26 July 1, 1999.
- 27 (2) In any fiscal year in which interest and dividends from
- 28 the investment of the funds in the Health Care Trust Fund are not
- 29 sufficient to fund the full amount of the annual transfer into the

- 30 Health Care Expendable Fund as required in subsection (1) of this
- 31 section, the State Treasurer shall transfer from tobacco
- 32 settlement installment payments an amount that is sufficient to
- 33 fully fund the amount of the annual transfer.
- 34 (3) The State Treasurer shall transfer Three Million Dollars
- 35 (\$3,000,000.00) of the 2002 tobacco settlement installment
- 36 payment, and from subsequent annual installment payments, into the
- 37 Health Care Expendable Fund, and said monies shall be appropriated
- 38 by the Legislature to the Medicaid assistance program to provide
- 39 care exclusively to patients with Alzheimer's disease. Said funds
- 40 shall be utilized to fund Alzheimer's patient care in at least one
- 41 (1) nursing home in each of the three (3) Mississippi Supreme
- 42 Court districts, to be designated by the State Department of
- 43 Health, at a rate of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) annually
- 44 per bed.
- 45 (4) All income from the investment of the funds in the
- 46 Health Care Expendable Fund shall be credited to the account of
- 47 the Health Care Expendable Fund. Any funds in the Health Care
- 48 Expendable Fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into
- 49 the State General Fund.
- 50 (5) The funds in the Health Care Expendable Fund shall be
- 51 available for expenditure pursuant to specific appropriation by
- 52 the Legislature beginning in fiscal year 2000, and shall be
- 53 expended exclusively for health care purposes.
- SECTION 2. Section 43-13-405, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 55 amended as follows:
- 56 43-13-405. (1) In accordance with the purposes of this
- 57 article, there is established in the State Treasury the Health
- 58 Care Trust Fund, into which shall be deposited Two Hundred Eighty
- 59 Million Dollars (\$280,000,000.00) of the funds received by the
- 60 State of Mississippi as a result of the tobacco settlement as of
- 61 the end of fiscal year 1999, and all tobacco settlement
- 62 installment payments made in subsequent years for which the use or

- 63 purpose for expenditure is not restricted by the terms of the
- 64 settlement, except as otherwise provided in Sections 43-13-407(2)
- and 43-13-407(3). All income from the investment of the funds in
- 66 the Health Care Trust Fund shall be credited to the account of the
- 67 Health Care Trust Fund. The funds in the Health Care Trust Fund
- 68 at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General
- 69 Fund.
- 70 (2) The Health Care Trust Fund shall remain inviolate and
- 71 shall never be expended, except as provided in this article. The
- 72 Legislature shall appropriate from the Health Care Trust Fund such
- 73 sums as are necessary to recoup any funds lost as a result of any
- 74 of the following actions:
- 75 (a) The federal Health Care Finance Administration, or
- 76 other agency of the federal government, is successful in recouping
- 77 tobacco settlement funds from the State of Mississippi;
- 78 (b) The federal share of funds for the support of the
- 79 Mississippi Medicaid Program is reduced directly or indirectly as
- 80 a result of the tobacco settlement;
- 81 (c) Federal funding for any other program is reduced as
- 82 a result of the tobacco settlement; or
- 83 (d) Tobacco cessation programs are mandated by the
- 84 federal government or court order.
- 85 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 86 and after its passage.
