1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 93-17-12, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2	TO PROVIDE THAT THE COST OF COURT-ORDERED HOME STUDIES BY SOCIAL
3	WORKERS SHALL BE PAID BY THE PARENT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
4	SERVICES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 93-17-12, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:
- 93-17-12. In any child custody matter hereafter filed in any chancery or county court in which the State of Mississippi or the
- 10 Department of Human Services is not a party, the court may impose
- 11 a fee for any court-ordered home study performed by the Department
- 12 of Human Services. The fee shall be assessed upon either party or
- 13 upon both parties in the court's discretion. The minimum fee
- 14 imposed shall be not less than Three Hundred Fifty Dollars
- 15 (\$350.00) for each household on which a home study is performed.
- 16 The fee shall be paid directly to the Mississippi Department of
- 17 Human Services prior to the home study being conducted by the
- 18 department. In no event, however, shall the cost of the home
- 19 study be borne by the Mississippi Department of Human Services.
- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2002.
