47 **SECTION 1.** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a member 48 of Lions of Mississippi, upon payment of the road and bridge

49 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 50 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 51 52 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 53 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 54 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a member of Lions of Mississippi. The distinctive license tags so issued 55 shall be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission, 56 with the advice of Lions of Mississippi, may prescribe and shall 57 consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary 58 59 to distinguish each license tag.

- (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.
- Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 69 (3) 70 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 71 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 72 73 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 74 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 75 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 76 77 time the original application is made for a distinctive license tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 78 79 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 80 license tag. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag in recognition of his support for the Mississippi Veterans Monument. The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as may be determined finally by the State Tax Commission based upon three (3) recommendations presented to the State Tax Commission by the Mississippi Veterans Monument Commission, and ranked in order of preference by the Mississippi Veterans Monument Commission.

Application for the distinctive license tags authorized by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector as a processing fee, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund. Distinctive license tags issued under this section shall be issued within forty-five (45) days after application is made.

Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 146 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license 147 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 148 149 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 150 applied for under this section which shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 151 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 152 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 153 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 154 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 155 156 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 157 license tag, or if the owner sells or transfers the vehicle, he 158 may surrender the license tag to the local county tax collector 159 and receive a certificate of credit toward the purchase of a tag 160 on another vehicle as otherwise provided by law. Distinctive 161 license tags issued under this section may be transferred by the 162 163 owner to any other vehicle owned by him upon payment of the regular taxes and fees for a license tag for that vehicle. 164

- (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the total fees collected under this section from the issuance of distinctive license tags under this section. The State Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

- There is established in the State Treasury a special 202 203 fund which shall consist of monies required to be deposited 204 therein under subsection (4) of this section. Monies in the 205 special fund, upon Legislative appropriation, may be expended by 206 the Mississippi Veterans Monument Commission for the purpose of performing any of the duties of the commission under Chapter 15 of 207 208 Title 55, Mississippi Code of 1972. Unexpended amounts remaining in the special fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse 209 210 into the State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment

earnings on amounts in the special fund shall be deposited to the 211 credit of the special fund. 212

The fund shall consist of monies required to be deposited therein under Section 3 of Senate Bill No. 2501, 2002 Regular Session, and such other monies as the Legislature may authorize or direct to be deposited into the fund. Monies in the fund, upon appropriation by the Legislature, may be expended by the Mississippi Department of Education to develop, implement and administer reading, character education and drop-out prevention programs. Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment earnings on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the fund.

SECTION 5. (1) In recognition of the patriotic services rendered the United States, Mississippi and the citizens thereof, any resident of the state who is on active duty with the Armed Forces of the United States, upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of

an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license plate or tag identifying him as an active duty member of the United States Armed Forces. The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag.

- (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for the distinctive license tag shall present proof of their active duty membership in the United States Armed Forces to the county tax collector. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.
- Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 327 328 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 329 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 330 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 331 other taxes and fees.
