The fund shall consist of 285 monies required to be deposited therein under Section 3 of Senate 286 287 Bill No. 2501, 2002 Regular Session, and such other monies as the Legislature may authorize or direct to be deposited into the fund. 288 289 Monies in the fund, upon appropriation by the Legislature, may be expended by the Mississippi Department of Education to develop, 290 implement and administer reading, character education and drop-out 291 292 prevention programs. Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General 293 294 Fund, and any interest earned or investment earnings on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the fund. 295

SECTION 5. (1) In recognition of the patriotic services rendered the United States, Mississippi and the citizens thereof, any resident of the state who is on active duty with the Armed Forces of the United States, upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license plate or tag identifying him as an active duty member of the United States Armed Forces. The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag.

(1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 1427 graduate of the United States Merchant Marine or a student enrolled at the United States Merchant Marine, upon complying with 1428 the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of 1429 motor vehicles, and upon payment of the road and bridge privilege 1430 taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law 1431 1432 for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional 1433 fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, 1434 shall be issued a distinctive license tag which displays the 1435 emblem of the United States Merchant Marine. The distinctive 1436 license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as the 1437 1438 State Tax Commission may prescribe and shall consist of such 1439 letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag. 1440

- (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.
- 1450 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 1451 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license 1452 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 1453 of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each distinctive license tag applied 1454 for under this section, which shall be in addition to all other

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taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of 1455 time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag 1456 year. The additional fee is due and payable at the time the 1457 1458 original application is made for a distinctive license tag under 1459 this section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal 1460 registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license 1461 tag. tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax collector. 1462

- (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:
- 1469 (a) Thirty-two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$32.50) of each
 1470 additional fee collected on distinctive license tags issued
 1471 pursuant to this section shall be deposited into the State General
 1472 Fund.

 1480 State Highway Fund to be expended solely for the repair,
 1481 maintenance, construction or reconstruction of highways.
- 1482 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
 1483 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag issued
 1484 under this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered
 1485 to the tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag
 1486 under this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2)
- 1487 license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this

1488 section, which will expire the same month and year as the regular 1489 license tag.

(6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and deposit in the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under this section.

1500 SECTION 21. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a graduate of the United States Air Force Academy or a student 1501 enrolled at the United States Air Force Academy, upon complying 1502 1503 with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing 1504 of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the road and bridge 1505 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 1506 1507 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 1508 1509 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag which displays the emblem of the United States Air Force Academy. 1510 distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and 1511 1512 design as the State Tax Commission may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to 1513 1514 distinguish each license tag.

1515 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized

1518 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less
1519 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,
1520 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis
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- as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.
- 1524 Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 1525 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license 1526 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each distinctive license tag applied 1527 for under this section, which shall be in addition to all other 1528 taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of 1529 time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag 1530 1531 The additional fee is due and payable at the time the original application is made for a distinctive license tag under 1532 1533 this section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license 1534 If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license 1535 tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax collector. 1536
- 1537 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
