## SENATE BILL NO. 2574

1 2 3 4 5 6	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF CHAPTER NO. 563, LAWS OF 1999, TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN TRACTS OF LAND ADJACENT TO THE HISTORIC SHAIFER HOUSE AND THE OLD MAGNOLIA CHURCH LOCATED ON THE PORT GIBSON BATTLEFIELD FROM THE GRAND GULF MILITARY MONUMENT COMMISSION TO THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY TO BE DEVELOPED AND MAINTAINED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter No. 563, Laws of 1999, is
9	hereby amended as follows:
10	Section 1. $(1)$ The Department of Finance and
11	Administration, on behalf of the State of Mississippi, may convey
12	all right, title and interest in certain state-owned real property
13	located in Claiborne County, Mississippi, to the State of
14	Mississippi, for the use and benefit of the Mississippi Department
15	of Archives and History, the property being known as the historic
16	Shaifer House and accompanying land located on the Port Gibson
17	Battlefield, and being more particularly described as follows:
18	Tract No. 1: That certain tract of land known
19	as the old Shaifer house tract; for survey,
20	begin at point on the southerly side of the
21	public road, where it is intersected by the
22	line between Parcels 1 and 2 of the partition
23	of the Shaifer Estate property as described in
24	partition deed executed by us and now recorded
25	Book 10-B, page 177 of the land records of
26	said county, and which partition deed together
27	with the plat recorded therewith is here
28	referred to for full description of the
29	location of said starting point, and run

30	thence in a northeasterly direction along said
31	old Port Gibson and Rodney public road, 1307
32	feet to point where said road is intersected
33	on its North side by a fence, and which point
34	is point of beginning for survey of this tract
35	(and which point is further located as being
36	North $88^{\circ}$ 45' East 1434.67 feet from the most
37	eastern corner of Section 16, Township 11
38	North, Range 2 East). From said point of
39	beginning run thence along fence, North $35^{\circ}$
40	West 134 feet; thence continue along fence,
41	South 35° West 15 feet, South 86° West 16 feet
42	to fence corner; thence along another fence,
43	North 40° West 191 feet to fence corner;
44	thence along another fence, North $40^{\circ}$ East $160$
45	feet; thence continue along fence, North $64^{\circ}$
46	East 217 feet to point on private farm road;
47	thence along said road, South $31^{\circ}~45^{\circ}$ East $372$
48	feet to point where the same forks; thence
49	along the fork going southwesterly 100 feet to
50	old Port Gibson and Rodney public/road; thence
51	along said old Port Gibson and Rodney public
52	road, in a southwesterly direction, 225 feet
53	to point of beginning. Said tract contains
54	3.0 acres, more or less, and lies in Section
55	Twelve (12), Township Eleven (11) North, Range
56	Two (2) East. Said land is the same as is
57	fully described in Section V of said above
58	mentioned partition deed executed by the
59	grantors, now recorded Book 10-B, page 177 of
60	the deed records of said Claiborne County,
61	which is here referred to in aid of
62	description and for all purposes. All of the

above is in accordance with survey made by 63 R.D. Wade, Jr., and copy of plat of his survey 64 is attached hereto and made a part hereof by 65 66 reference. 67 Tract No. 2: That certain tract of land being the site of the old Magnolia Church; to arrive 68 at point of beginning for survey of this 69 tract, begin at the most eastern corner of 70 Section Sixteen (16), Township Eleven (11) 71 North, Range Two (2) East, and run thence 72 South 74° 34' East 2,917.7 feet to stake on 73 South side of public road, and run thence 74 South 84° 45' East 49 feet to fence corneron 75 South side of said road, which is point of 76 beginning for survey of this tract; and which 77 point is also the point where the East line of 78 Parcel 2 in the partition of the Shaifer 79 80 Estate property as described in partition deed executed by us and now recorded Book 10-B, 81 82 page 177 of the land records of said Claiborne County, intersects said public road, and which 83 partition deed, together with plat recorded 84 therewith, is here referred to in aid of 85 description of location of said starting 86 point. From said point of beginning, continue 87 thence along road, South 84° 45' East 282.04 88 feet to stake in fence and property line; 89 thence along fence and property line, South 90 46° West 396 feet to stake in fence corner; 91 thence along fence (which is the East line of 92 Parcel 2 of the partition above referred to), 93 North 17 East 109 feet, North 16° East 69 94 feet, North 2°, West 52 feet and North 16° 95

96	West 78 feet to point of beginning. Said
97	tract contains 1.29 acres, more or less, and
98	lies in Section Twelve (12), Township Eleven
99	(11) North, Range Two (2) East.
100	The Secretary of State shall approve this conveyance and join
101	in this conveyance for all purposes.
102	(2) The Department of Finance and Administration, on behalf
103	of the State of Mississippi and the Grand Gulf Military Monument
104	Commission, may further convey all right, title and interest in
105	certain state-owned real property located in Claiborne County,
106	Mississippi, to the State of Mississippi, for the use and benefit
107	of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History, the
108	property being two (2) tracts of land that were donated to the
109	Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission in January of 1980, by Mr.
110	A.K. Shaifer, and being more particularly described as follows:
111	Tract No. 1: A tract of land which adjoins
112	the tract sometimes known as the old Shaifer
113	house tract and which old Shaifer house tract
114	is Tract No. 1 in the deed from A.K. Shaifer,
115	S.B. Shaifer, Laura P. Shaifer, and Estelle S.
116	Montgomery to the State of Mississippi for the
117	use and benefit of the Grand Gulf Military
118	Monument Commission, which was executed on
119	December 28, 1979, and recorded in Book 10-F,
120	page 425-430 of the deed records of said
121	Claiborne County. For survey of this tract,
122	begin at the most southerly or southwesterly
123	corner of said old Shaifer house tract as
124	described in said above mentioned deed and
125	which is on the northerly side of the public
126	road running through said old Shaifer property
127	and which deed is here referred to for
128	description of location of the starting point

129	hereof; from said point of beginning, run
130	thence along the northerly wayline of said
131	public road South 67 degrees 45' West 70 feet
132	to stake; thence leave road and run thence
133	North 52 degrees 30' West 843.05 feet to
134	stake; thence run North 43 degrees 31' East
135	631.74 feet to stake on Easterly side of
136	private ridge road; thence along the easterly
137	side of said ridge road South 44 degrees 30'
138	East 195 feet, South 39 degrees 28' East 290
139	feet, South 37 degrees 45' East 111 feet to
140	stake on Northerly or Northeasterly corner of
141	said Shaifer house tract; thence around said
142	old Shaifer house tract site South 64 degrees
143	West 217 feet; thence South 40 degrees West
144	191 feet; thence South 40 degrees East 190
145	feet; thence South 86 degrees East 16 feet;
146	thence North 35 degrees East 15 feet; thence
147	South 35 degrees East 134 feet to point of
148	beginning. Said tract contains 8.32 acres,
149	more or less, and lies in Section 12, Township
150	11 North, Range 2 East, all in accordance with
151	survey made by R.D. Wade, Jr. dated September
152	4, 1979, which is attached hereto as Exhibit
153	"A" and made a part hereof for all purposes.
154	Said tract is the same as is described in
155	Tract No. 1 of the Deed of Gift from A.K.
156	Shaifer to the State of Mississippi for the
157	use and benefit of the Grand Gulf Military
158	Monument Commission executed on January 18,
159	1980, and recorded in Book 10-H, page 9-13.
160	Tract No. 2: A tract of land which adjoins
161	the site of the old Magnolia Church and which

162	Magnolia Church site is Tract No. 2 in the
163	above mentioned deed from A.K. Shaifer, S.B.
164	Shaifer, Laura P. Shaifer, and Estelle S.
165	Montgomery to the State of Mississippi for the
166	use and benefit of the Grand Gulf Military
167	Monument Commission. For survey of the tract
168	hereby conveyed, begin at the Northwest corner
169	of the said old Magnolia Church site as
170	described in said deed above referred to and
171	which deed is here referred to for description
172	of location of said starting point; from said
173	starting point, run thence South 16 degrees
174	East 78 feet; thence run South 2 degrees East
175	52 feet; thence run South 16 degrees West 69
176	feet; thence run South 17 degrees West 109
177	feet to stake at southerly corner of said old
178	Magnolia Church site; run thence North 79
179	degrees 34' West 364.04 feet to stake; thence
180	North 53 degrees 45' East 396 feet to stake;
181	thence South 84 degrees 45' East 49 feet to
182	point of beginning. Said tract contains 1.87
183	acres, more or less, and lies in Section 12,
184	Township 11 North, Range 2 East; all of the
185	above in accordance with survey made by R.D.
186	Wade, Jr. dated September 4, 1979, and plat of
187	survey showing this tract and the old Magnolia
188	Church site referred to above is attached
189	hereto as Exhibit "B" and made a part hereof
190	for all purposes. Said tract is the same as
191	is described in Tract No. 2 of the Deed of
192	Gift from A.K. Shaifer to the State of
193	Mississippi for the use and benefit of the
194	Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission

195	executed on January 18, 1980, and recorded in
196	Book 10-H, page 9-13.
197	The Secretary of State shall approve this conveyance and join
198	in this conveyance for all purposes.
199	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
200	and after its passage.
