## SENATE BILL NO. 2592

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-64.5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REVISE THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR RESIDENT AND NONRESIDENT COMMERCIAL 2 3 SHRIMP LICENSES; TO PROVIDE A LICENSE AND FEE SCHEDULE FOR CERTAIN 4 TYPES OF COMMERCIAL GEAR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 49-15-64.5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 8 49-15-64.5. 51	(3) Every <u>vessel,</u> freight boat, ice boat and catching boat
52	used in catching or transporting saltwater shrimp taken from the

54	or for canning, packing, freezing, drying or as bait shall
55	register the name of the captain of the vessel at the time that
56	the vessel obtains the annual privilege license provided for in
57	this section. The individual registered as the captain of the

59	of the deputy director or the deputy director's designated
60	representative. The captain shall purchase a license entitled

63 vessel and gear. \* \* \*

64 (4) During open seasons and in open areas, saltwater shrimp
65 may be taken only with shrimp trawls, trawls, butterfly nets,
66 skimmer nets, push trawls, beach seines and cast nets.

67 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 68 and after July 1, 2002.
