SENATE BILL NO. 2611

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ANY COUNTY TO
2 ADOPT REASONABLE ORDINANCES TO LICENSE THE USE OF ALL-TERRAIN
3 VEHICLES ON PUBLIC STREETS OR ROADS UNDER ITS JURISDICTION; AND
4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** The board of supervisors of any county shall have
7 the power to adopt reasonable ordinances to license the use of
8 all-terrain vehicles on public streets or roads under its
9 jurisdiction. The ordinances shall require an annual registration
10 fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each vehicle to be paid
11 into the county treasury. The ordinances shall require all
12 persons operating the vehicles to wear a safety helmet and use
13 headlights at all times of operation. The ordinances may contain
14 additional provisions regulating the use of all-terrain vehicles
15 as long as the provisions are not inconsistent with this section.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
17 and after July 1, 2002.
