- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-35-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 37-35-9. The State Board for Community and Junior Colleges
- 9 is authorized to develop and establish general educational
- 10 development preparatory classes in secondary schools and
- 11 community/junior colleges and to provide financial assistance from
- 12 the state for the specific purpose of preparing persons sixteen
- 13 (16) years of age and older, not enrolled in school or required to
- 14 be enrolled in school by the Compulsory School Attendance Law
- 15 (Section 37-13-91) to successfully write the general educational
- 16 development test and earn a certificate of equivalency which is
- 17 equivalent to the high school diploma.
- 18 The State Board for Community and Junior Colleges is
- 19 authorized to administer the General Educational Development (GED)
- 20 Testing Program in accordance with the policies and guidelines of
- 21 the GED Testing Service of the American Council on Education.
- 22 Such administration shall include the approval of rules and
- 23 regulations for the administration, scoring, issuing of
- 24 transcripts and awarding of diplomas for the GED Testing Program.
- 25 The State Board for Community and Junior Colleges is hereby
- 26 authorized to receive income and to set fees for the scoring of
- 27 test, the issuing of transcripts and the issuing of diplomas to
- 28 adequately administer the GED Testing Program.

- 38 a program of general educational development (GED) preparatory
- 39 instruction * * *.
- 40 Adult students for general educational development
- 41 preparatory classes may be accepted by schools and junior colleges
- 42 from any area of the state provided students are bona fide
- 43 residents of Mississippi.
- Instructors, counselors and supervisors utilized in the
- 45 teaching of general educational development preparatory classes
- 46 shall be licensed in the appropriate area as required by the State
- 47 Board for Community and Junior Colleges.
- 48 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 49 and after July 1, 2002.
