SENATE BILL NO. 2633

AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL STUDENTS IN PUBLIC UNIVERSITY SCHOOLS 1 OF EDUCATION TO COMPLETE TWO COURSES IN MULTICULTURAL 2 UNDERSTANDING; TO REQUIRE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING TO PRESCRIBE THE CURRICULUM FOR 3 4 SUCH COURSEWORK; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) All students attending a college of education in any public institution of higher learning in 8 Mississippi shall complete two (2) courses in multicultural 9 understanding prior to graduation. Courses in multicultural 10 understanding shall be in two (2) categories: cross-cultural 11 studies and diversity in Western experience. Each such student 12 shall complete nine (9) hours credit from each category. 13 The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher 14 (2) Learning, with the assistance of the Commission on Teacher and 15 Administrator Education, Certification and Development, shall 16 prescribe the courses which are approved to comply with the 17 requirements of this act. Such coursework in multicultural 18 understanding shall be approved in the following areas: 19 Area I - Communications 20 21 Area II - History 22 Area III - Social Studies 23 Area IV - Humanities Area V - Natural Science 24 Area VI - Fine and Performing Arts 25 The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher (3) 26 27 Learning shall require the Multicultural Understanding Curriculum

in all public colleges of education beginning with the 2002-2003 school year.

30 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 31 and after July 1, 2002.
