- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8
- SECTION 1. Section 45-37-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, which 9
- 10 provides for the enforcement and supremacy of state law over local
- law of a chapter that has been repealed in its entirety except for 11
- this section, is repealed. 12
- SECTION 2. Section 97-32-2, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 13
- 14 amended as follows:
- 15 97-32-2. It is the intent of the Legislature that
- enforcement of this chapter be implemented in an equitable manner 16
- throughout the state so as to ensure the eligibility for and 17
- receipt of any federal funds or grants that the State of 18
- Mississippi now $\underline{\text{receives or }}\underline{\text{may receive relating to the provisions}}$ 19
- 20 of this chapter. The provisions of Sections 97-32-5, 97-32-7,
- 97-32-11, 97-32-15, 97-32-17, 97-32-19 and 97-32-21 shall 21
- supersede any existing or subsequently enacted local law, 22
- 23 ordinance or regulation which relates to the sale, promotion and
- distribution of tobacco and tobacco products. 24
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 25
- and after its passage. 26
