- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. (1) The following highway is designated as a 6
- state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi 7
- Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the 8
- 9 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
- links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be 10
- the state highway system of Mississippi: 11

## Northern District - Coahoma County: 12

- That segment of highway beginning Six-tenths (.6) of a mile east of the termination of state maintenance of 14 Mississippi Highway 316 and extending northwesterly to 15 the intersection of U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway 61, 16 17 and that segment of highway extending westerly from the
- intersection of U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway 61 to 18
- its intersection with the eastern city limits of Friars 19
- Point, Mississippi. 20

- The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take 21
- over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of 22
- the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this 23
- 24 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
- highway has been brought up to commission standards and all 25
- utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such 26
- highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated. 27

28 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

29 and after July 1, 2002.
