- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. (1) The Parole Board shall maintain a central
- 7 registry of paroled inmates. The Parole Board shall place the
- 8 following information on the registry: name, address, photograph,
- 9 crime for which paroled, the date of the end of parole or flat
- 10 time date and other information deem necessary. The Parole Board
- 11 shall immediately remove information on a parolee at the end of
- 12 his parole or flat time date.
- 13 (2) When a person is placed on parole, the Parole Board
- 14 shall inform the person of the duty to report to the Parole Board
- 15 any change in address ten (10) days before changing address.
- 16 (3) The Parole Board shall utilize an internet website or
- 17 other electronic means to release or publish the information.
- 18 (4) Records maintained on the registry shall be open to law
- 19 enforcement agencies and the public.
- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2002.
