- 7 SECTION 1. Section 71-3-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 8
- 9 This chapter shall be known and cited as "Workers'
- Compensation Law," and shall be administered by the Workers' 10
- Compensation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the 11
- "commission," cooperating with other state and federal authorities 12
- 13 for the prevention of injuries and occupational diseases to
- 14 workers and, in event of injury or occupational disease, their
- rehabilitation or restoration to health and vocational 15
- opportunity; and this chapter shall be fairly and impartially 16
- construed and applied according to the law and the evidence in the 17
- record, and this chapter shall not be presumed to favor one (1) 18
- 19 party over the other.
- Wherever used in this chapter, or in any other statute or 20
- rule or regulation affecting the former Workmen's Compensation Law 21
- 22 and any of its functions or duties:
- 23 (a) \* \* \* "Workmen's compensation" means "workers'
- 24 compensation"; and
- (b) \* \* \* "Commission" means the Workers' Compensation 25

- 27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
