## SENATE BILL NO. 2775

- AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 25-11-116.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
- 2 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT CONSERVATION OFFICERS EMPLOYED BY THE 3 DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS WHO HAVE AT LEAST
- 4 TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OF CREDITABLE SERVICE OR WHO ARE AT LEAST FIFTY-
- 5 FIVE YEARS OF AGE AND WHO RETIRE BEFORE JULY 1, 2002, SHALL BE
- 6 CREDITED WITH AN ADDITIONAL TWO YEARS OF SERVICE; AND FOR RELATED
- 7 PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** The following provision shall be codified as
- 10 Section 25-11-116.1, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 11  $\underline{25-11-116.1.}$  (1) Any member of the system who is a
- 12 conservation officer employed by the Department of Wildlife,
- 13 Fisheries and Parks who has twenty-five (25) years of creditable
- 14 service or who is at least fifty-five (55) years of age who
- 15 withdraws from service after the effective date of this section
- 16 and before July 1, 2002, and receives a retirement allowance shall
- 17 be credited with two (2) additional years of service in the
- 18 calculations of the annual retirement allowance.
- 19 (2) The Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks shall
- 20 contribute fourteen and three-quarters percent (14.75%) of the
- 21 compensation earned by the employee during the twenty-four (24)
- 22 months immediately preceding his withdrawal for the additional two
- (2) years of creditable service as allowed in subsection (1). All
- 24 contributions and wage reports shall be filed with the retirement
- 25 system before the member can receive the additional creditable
- 26 service in the annual retirement allowance.
- 27 (3) The member's average compensation, as provided for in
- 28 Section 25-11-103(e), may include the compensation on which
- 29 additional contributions are paid.

- 30 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 31 and after its passage.
