5	SECTION 1. Section 49-1-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6	amended as follows:
7	49-1-37. The edible portions of all game or fur-bearing
8	animals, game birds, and fish seized under the provisions of this
9	chapter or any other law for the protection of wild animals,
10	birds, or fish, shall be disposed of by the department or under
11	its direction to $\underline{\text{needy recipients}}$, charitable institutions * * *
12	within the state and to local law enforcement agencies having
13	facilities to prepare food for prisoners. Skins or pelts of
14	fur-bearing animals, taken illegally, may be seized and sold by
15	order of the department, and the funds received for same shall be
16	paid into the Fisheries and Wildlife Fund. Nongame birds, $\underline{\text{fish}}$
17	and animals or parts thereof, and the plumes or skins of game
18	birds of foreign species shall be disposed of by the department,
19	or under its direction, by gift to scientific institutions, or, ir
20	the discretion of the department, they shall be kept by it for
21	scientific or educational purposes, or may be destroyed. The
22	officer disposing of any such animals, birds, fish or parts
23	thereof, shall take a receipt from the donee for any such gift,
24	which receipt shall be filed in the office of the department, and
25	the department shall keep a permanent record of such gifts.
