 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 59-21-85, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, <u>TO EXEMPT NONRESIDENTS ONLY FROM THE BOATING CERTIFICATE</u>
 <u>REQUIREMENT IF</u> RENTING BOAT FROM PERSON ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF RENTING BOATS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 59-21-85, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 59-21-85. (1) (a) No motorboat required to be numbered 9 under this chapter shall be operated by any person who is under 10 the age of twelve (12) years, unless he possesses a certificate as 11 required under this section and is also accompanied by a parent, 12 guardian or other person who is at least twenty-one (21) years of 13 age and qualified and capable of operating the same.

(b) A motorboat required to be numbered under this
chapter may not be operated by any person born after June 30,
1980, unless the person has completed a course in boating safety
conducted or approved by the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and
Parks, and the person has in his immediate possession while
operating a motorboat a certificate of satisfactory completion of
the boating safety course.

(c) The requirement of possessing a certificate under this subsection shall not apply to any <u>nonresident</u> operating a motorboat that is rented from a person engaged in the business of renting motorboats.

(2) Boating safety courses shall be held by the Department
of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, or instructors designated and
approved by the department. The Department of Wildlife, Fisheries

28 and Parks shall issue a certificate to each person who

29 satisfactorily completes the boating safety course.

30 (3) In lieu of any other penalties provided for a violation
31 of this chapter, a violation of this section is punishable by a
32 fine of not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than
33 Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

34 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 35 and after its passage.
