SENATE BILL NO. 2784

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-37, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE PRIMITIVE WEAPON LICENSE DURING SPECIAL HUNTS; AND FOR RELATED FOR PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 49-7-37. (1) Any resident of this state licensed to hunt or
- 8 otherwise take any legal game bird or game animal in this state by
- 9 or with the use of firearms, may hunt, kill, shoot or otherwise
- 10 take game animals or game birds by the use of falcons or hawks as
- 11 may be prescribed by the commission and in compliance with federal
- 12 quidelines.
- 13 (2) The commission may extend the special archery seasons on
- 14 any public hunting projects, game refuges or prescribed areas
- 15 having surplus deer populations.
- 16 (3) The killing by primitive firearms of an antlerless deer
- 17 or any other deer protected during the regular deer season is
- 18 prohibited, but the commission may designate areas of the state in
- 19 which the killing of antlerless deer may be permitted or limited.
- 20 (4) The commission may make reasonable rules and regulations
- 21 concerning the special seasons with falcons and hawks, bow and
- 22 arrow and primitive firearms which it deems necessary and proper.
- 23 The commission shall define the term "primitive firearm" for
- 24 purposes of this section and other law or regulation.
- 25 (5) The use of dogs shall be prohibited for hunting deer
- 26 during any of the special hunting seasons.

27	(6) In addition to a nunting license allowing the taking of
28	deer, any resident desiring to hunt deer with bow and arrow or
29	primitive firearm during primitive weapon or archery season <u>or</u>
30	special hunts established by the commission shall purchase a
31	special resident archery and/or primitive firearms license at a

- 32 fee of Fourteen Dollars (\$14.00) for each license plus the fee
- 33 provided in Section 49-7-17.
- 34 (7) Any person violating this section is guilty of a Class
- 35 II violation and shall be punished as provided in Section
- 36 49-7-143.
- 37 (8) All seasons provided for herein shall begin on Saturday.
- 38 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 39 and after July 1, 2002.
