- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 45-9-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 45-9-31. Any physician, surgeon, dentist, veterinarian, 8
- 9 paramedical employee, or nurse, or any employee of a hospital,
- 10 clinic, or any other medical institution or office where patients
- regularly receive care, who treats, at any location, any human 11
- being suffering from a wound or injury and who has reason to 12
- believe or ought to know that the wound or injury was caused by 13
- gunshot or knifing, or receiving a request for such treatment, 14
- shall report the same immediately to the municipal police 15
- department or sheriff's office of the municipality or county in 16
- 17 which such treatment is administered or request for such treatment
- is received. If the wound or injury is the result of a hunting or 18
- boating accident, the injury shall be reported immediately to the 19
- 20 Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks.
- Any person making a report or the reports required by this 21
- section shall be immune from civil liability for the making of the 22
- 23 said reports.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 24
- and after July 1, 2002. 25
