SENATE BILL NO. 2845

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-3-42, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 AUTHORIZE BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS TO MAINTAIN PRIVATE ROADS OR
- 3 DRIVEWAYS USED AS TURNAROUNDS BY HEAD START BUSES; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 19-3-42, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 19-3-42. (1) The board of supervisors of any county is
- 9 hereby authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to grade,
- 10 gravel or shell, repair, and/or maintain private gravel or shell
- 11 roads or driveways to private residences if the roads or driveways
- 12 are used for school bus turnarounds, including Head Start program
- 13 buses or any successor to that program.
- 14 (2) Prior to engaging in the work authorized in subsection
- 15 (1) of this section, the board of supervisors shall spread upon
- 16 the official minutes of the board:
- 17 (a) The written request of the school board or local
- 18 Head Start administrator for such work;
- 19 (b) The written approval of the board of supervisors
- 20 for such work;
- 21 (c) The specific location of the road or driveway to be
- 22 worked; and
- 23 (d) The name of the owner of the road or driveway to be
- 24 worked.
- 25 (3) The written request of the school board or local Head
- 26 Start administrator, as required in subsection (2)(a) above, shall
- 27 contain a current list of all active * * * bus turnarounds
- 28 presently in use * * * or contemplated for use * * * for the

- 29 present school year. The approval by the board of supervisors
- 30 shall be valid and effective for the period of time that a
- 31 turnaround is anticipated for use, but not for a period greater
- 32 than one (1) year.
- 33 (4) * * * The board of supervisors of any county is further
- 34 authorized, in its discretion, to maintain public school grounds
- of the county and to grade, gravel, shell or overlay, and/or to
- 36 maintain gravel, shell, asphalt or concrete roads, driveways or
- 37 parking lots of public schools of the county if, before engaging
- 38 in the work, the board of supervisors shall spread upon its
- 39 official minutes the written request of the school board for the
- 40 work, the written approval of the board of supervisors for $\underline{\text{the}}$
- 41 work and the specific location of the school grounds or road,
- 42 driveway or parking lot, to be worked.
- 43 (5) * * * The board of supervisors of any county is hereby
- 44 authorized, in its discretion, to repair and maintain driveways
- 45 and parking lots of: (a) any nonprofit organization in the county
- 46 which is tax exempt under Section 501(c) of the United States
- 47 Internal Revenue Code and which has as one (1) of its primary
- 48 purposes for organization to aid and assist in the rehabilitation
- 49 of persons suffering from drug abuse or drug addiction; and (b)
- 50 any private, nonprofit cemeteries in the county. The board of
- 51 supervisors of any county shall not be authorized under the
- 52 provisions of this subsection to repair or maintain driveways or
- 53 parking lots located more than one hundred fifty (150) feet from
- 54 the center of any highway, road or street under the jurisdiction
- 55 of the county.
- 56 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 57 and after its passage.
