SENATE BILL NO. 2873 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 69-15-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO TRANSFER SUPERVISION, MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF THE VETERINARY 2 DIAGNOSTIC LABORATORY TO THE COLLEGE OF VETERINARY MEDICINE AT 3 MISSISSIPPI STATE UNIVERSITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 69-15-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 69-15-11. * * * 8 9 (1) The College of Veterinary Medicine at Mississippi State University of Agriculture and Applied Science shall maintain a 10 complete and adequate veterinary diagnostic laboratory in the 11 Jackson vicinity and any person licensed to practice veterinary 12 medicine, veterinary surgery, veterinary dentistry, or any 13 vocational-agriculture teacher, bona fide farmer or county agent 14 in the State of Mississippi or agent of the State Veterinarian 15 16 shall have made available to him services of the laboratory. The laboratory shall examine and conduct laboratory tests on specimens 17 submitted by any licensed veterinarian, or vocational-agriculture 18 teacher, bona fide farmer or county agent of this state or agent 19 of the State Veterinarian and issue appropriate reports. The 20 College of Veterinary Medicine shall be required to set reasonable 21 fees for such examinations, tests, reports or other diagnostic 22 23 service. (2) The College of Veterinary Medicine shall select a 24 director of the laboratory who holds a degree of veterinary 25 26 medicine from a recognized college or university; is board

certified in one (1) of the following basic diagnostic

disciplines; toxicology, pathology, microbiology, virology or

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30 <u>clinical diagnosis for at least ten (10) years, five (5) years of</u>
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clinical pathology and has engaged in the practice of veterinary

- 31 which were in a supervisory capacity. The director shall select
- 32 and recommend for employment such veterinarians, bacteriologists,
- 33 pathologists, technicians, clerical assistants, and other
- 34 personnel necessary to carry out the objective of this section.
- 35 The salaries, compensation and expenses of such employees shall be
- 36 sufficient to insure the employment of competent persons and shall
- 37 be paid from funds at the disposal of the Veterinary Diagnostic
- 38 Laboratory. The director shall be responsible to the College of
- 39 Veterinary Medicine for the daily operations of the laboratory.
- 40 (3) There is created an advisory council to advise the
- 41 College of Veterinary Medicine on matters concerning the
- 42 <u>Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory</u>. The council shall be composed
- 43 of the Chairman of the Senate Agriculture Committee, or his
- 44 <u>designee;</u> the Chairman of the House Agriculture Committee, <u>or his</u>
- 45 <u>designee;</u> the Chairman of the Board of Animal Health; the
- 46 Commissioner of Agriculture and Commerce; a person appointed by
- 47 the President of Alcorn State University from its land grant staff
- 48 who is not a member of the Board of Animal Health; a licensed and
- 49 practicing veterinarian appointed by the President of the
- 50 Mississippi State Veterinary Medical Association who is not a
- 51 member of the Board of Animal Health; the State Veterinarian; the
- 52 State Chemist; and the Dean of the College of Veterinary Medicine.
- 53 This advisory council shall meet at least twice a year, upon
- 54 written notification at least fourteen (14) days in advance, to be
- 55 called by the Dean of the College of Veterinary Medicine. A
- 56 meeting may also be called by the Commissioner of Agriculture or
- 57 by a majority of the advisory council with fourteen (14) days'
- 58 written notice.

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The members of the advisory council shall serve in an

- 60 advisory capacity only. For attending meetings of the council,
- 61 legislators shall receive per diem and expenses which shall be

- in the same amounts provided for committee meetings when the
- 64 Legislature is not in session; however, no per diem or expenses
- 65 for attending meetings of the council shall be paid while the
- 66 Legislature is in session. No per diem and expenses shall be paid
- 67 except for attending meetings of the council without prior
- 68 approval of the proper committee in their respective houses.
- 69 (4) All funds, property and other assets and all current
- 70 positions of the diagnostic laboratory shall be transferred to the
- 71 College of Veterinary Medicine on July 1, 2002. The budget of the
- 72 Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory shall be funded as a separate
- 73 line item within the general appropriation bill for the College of
- 74 Veterinary Medicine.
- 75 (5) Information and records pertaining to all animal
- 76 diseases within the state will be kept confidential except for
- 77 those reports concerning diseases that are specifically regulated
- 78 for mandatory control and eradication, or when release of such
- 79 information is deemed necessary by the State Veterinarian to
- 80 protect the public health, other livestock or wildlife.
- 81 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 82 and after July 1, 2002.
