SENATE BILL NO. 2883

AN ACT TO CREATE A "REGIONAL ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL PILOT PROGRAM 1 (R.A.S.P.) " WHICH SHALL BE AN INTERDICTION RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM FOR 2 CHILDREN GRADES 9 THROUGH 12 WHO ARE NOT APPROPRIATE FOR REFERRAL TO LOCAL ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL PROGRAMS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF SAID PROGRAM BY THE DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES 3 4 5 OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** (1) There is created under the Division of Youth 8 Services of the Department of Human Services a program to be known 9 10 as the "Regional Alternative School Pilot Program (R.A.S.P.)." The program shall be an interdiction/boot camp style program 11 designed for children in Grades 9 through 12 who are determined to 12 be inappropriate for the alternative school programs operated by 13 14 the local school districts. The program shall be located in a properly licensed residential facility located in Noxubee County 15 or a county adjacent to Noxubee County. 16

The Division of Youth Services of the Department of 17 (2) Human Services shall implement and administer the Regional 18 Alternative School Pilot Program and shall promulgate rules and 19 regulations concerning the administration of the program. 20 The Division of Youth Services shall prepare written guidelines 21 concerning the nomination and selection process of participants in 22 the program, and such guidelines shall include a list of the 23 factors considered in the selection process. 24

(3) Participation in the Regional Alternative School Pilot
Program shall be on a voluntary basis. No child may be sentenced
by any court to participate in the program; however, a youth court
judge may refer the program to a child when, under his

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29 determination, such program would be sufficient to meet the needs 30 of the child.

(4) The Division of Youth Services may award an adult high 31 32 school diploma to each participant who meets the minimum academic 33 requirements prescribed by the State Board of Education for graduation from the Regional Alternative School Pilot Program. 34 Participants in the program who do not meet the minimum academic 35 requirements may be awarded a special certificate of attendance. 36 The State Board of Education shall establish rules and regulations 37 for awarding the adult high school diploma and shall prescribe the 38 39 form for such diploma and the certificate of attendance.

40 (5) The Department of Human Services may accept any 41 available funds that may be used to defray the expenses of the 42 program, including, but not limited to, federal funding, public or 43 private funds and any funds that may be appropriated by the 44 Legislature for that purpose.

45 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 46 and after July 1, 2002.
