## SENATE BILL NO. 2888

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-313, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT A SALTWATER SPORTS FISHING LICENSE SHALL BE VALID FOR 12 MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-15-313, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 49-15-313. (1) Any resident between the ages of sixteen
- 8 (16) and sixty-five (65) years, as defined in Section 49-7-3,
- 9 fishing in the marine waters of the state, shall obtain a
- 10 saltwater sports fishing license for a fee of Four Dollars
- 11 (\$4.00). This license shall be valid in any waters south of
- 12 Interstate 10. The license shall be valid for a period of twelve
- 13 (12) months from the date of issuance. Any resident citizen who
- 14 is blind, paraplegic or a multiple amputee, or who has been
- 15 adjudged by the Veterans Administration as having a total
- 16 service-connected disability, or has been adjudged totally
- 17 disabled by the Social Security Administration shall not be
- 18 required to purchase or have in his possession a saltwater sports
- 19 fishing license while engaged in such activities. Any resident
- 20 exempt under this section shall have on his person while fishing
- 21 proof of residency and age or disability.
- 22 (2) The commission shall prescribe the forms, types and fees
- 23 for nonresident saltwater sports fishing licenses except that the
- 24 fee for a nonresident saltwater sports fishing license shall not
- 25 be less than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). The commission shall
- 26 require a nonresident to purchase a nonresident freshwater fishing
- 27 license and a nonresident saltwater sports fishing license if the

- 28 nonresident's state requires both licenses for a nonresident to
- 29 fish in its marine waters.
- 30 (3) All resident vessels engaged in charter boat fishing,
- 31 party boat fishing, head boat and guide boat fishing shall be
- 32 issued a separate annual license by the commission at a fee of Two
- 33 Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). All nonresident vessels engaged in
- 34 charter boat fishing, party boat fishing, headboat and guide boat
- 35 fishing shall be issued a separate annual license by the
- 36 commission. The commission shall set the fees for nonresident
- 37 vessel licenses as provided in Section 49-15-30. Crew members and
- 38 customers of the licensed vessels shall not be required to
- 39 purchase an individual resident or nonresident saltwater fishing
- 40 license while sponsored by the licensed vessels. An operator of a
- 41 licensed vessel shall be required to report the number of
- 42 customers to the department as required by the commission and the
- 43 information shall be kept confidential and shall not be released,
- 44 except to other fisheries management agencies or as statistical
- 45 data. All nonresident vessels engaged in saltwater sport fishing
- 46 tournaments, not to exceed an aggregate of twenty (20) days per
- 47 calendar year, shall not be required to purchase an annual license
- 48 as provided under this subsection.
- 49 (4) The saltwater sports fishing license is required for all
- 50 recreational methods of finfish harvest.
- 51 (5) Any resident who purchases a lifetime sportsman's
- 52 license, in accordance with Section 49-7-153, shall be entitled to
- 53 fish in the marine salt waters of the state and shall be exempt
- 54 from the purchase of a sport saltwater fishing license.
- 55 (6) Any person authorized to issue a license may collect and
- 56 retain, for each saltwater fishing license issued, the additional
- 57 fee authorized under Section 49-7-17.
- 58 (7) The fees collected from the sale of resident and
- 59 nonresident saltwater sports fishing licenses shall be deposited

- 60 into the Seafood Fund and shall be used solely for the management
- of marine resources.
- 62 (8) Participants in the Very Special Fishing Olympics are
- 63 exempt from this section.
- 64 (9) July 4 of each year is designated as "Free Saltwater
- 65 Sports Fishing Day." Any person may saltwater sport fish without
- 66 a license on the "Free Saltwater Sports Fishing Day."
- 67 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 68 and after July 1, 2002.
