## SENATE BILL NO. 2920

AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO WILLFULLY HARM OR KILL ANY
PUBLIC SERVICE ANIMAL; TO PROVIDE CRIMINAL PENALTIES AND REQUIRE
RESTITUTION FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) It is unlawful for any person to willfully
- 6 and maliciously taunt, torment, tease, beat, strike, or administer
- 7 or subject any desensitizing drugs, chemicals or substance to any
- 8 public service animal; and any person who violated this section is
- 9 guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be
- 10 fined not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and be
- 11 imprisoned not more than five (5) days or both.
- 12 (2) Any person who, without just cause, purposely kills or
- 13 injures any public service animal is guilty of a felony and upon
- 14 conviction shall be fined not more than Five Thousand Dollars
- 15 (\$5,000.00) and be imprisoned not more than five (5) years or
- 16 both.
- 17 (3) For purposes of this section, the words "public service
- 18 animal" shall mean any animal, including, but not limited to,
- 19 canines (K-9 dogs) trained to assist a law enforcement or any
- 20 public safety entity; including, but not limited to, dogs
- 21 certified by the Mississippi Law Enforcement K-9 Association as
- 22 "Bomb Dog," "Patrol Dog," "Drug Dog," "Arson Dog," "Search and
- 23 Rescue Dog" and "Cadaver Dog."
- 24 (4) Any person guilty of violating subsection 2 of this
- 25 section shall also be required to make restitution to the law
- 26 enforcement agency or owner so aggrieved.

- 27 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 28 and after July 1, 2002.
