COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2958

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-1211, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REQUIRE PRIVATE PRISONS HOUSING STATE INMATES TO PURCHASE 2 PRISON CLOTHING AND BEDDING FROM MISSISSIPPI PRISON INDUSTRIES IF 3 4 IT SUBMITS A COMPETITIVE BID; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 47-5-1211, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 47-5-1211. (1) A contract for private correctional 8 9 facilities or services shall not be entered into unless the contractor has demonstrated that it has: 10 The qualifications, experience and management 11 (a) personnel necessary to carry out the terms of the contract. 12 The ability to expedite the siting, design and (b) 13 construction of correctional facilities. 14 The ability to comply with applicable laws, court (C) 15 orders and national correctional standards. 16 (d) Demonstrated history of successful operation and 17 management of other correctional facilities. 18 A facility shall at all times comply with all federal 19 (2) and state laws, and all applicable court orders. 20 (3) (a) No contract for private incarceration shall be 21 entered into unless the cost of the private operation, including 22 the state's cost for monitoring the private operation, offers a 23 cost savings of at least ten percent (10%) to the Department of 24 Corrections for at least the same level and quality of service 25 26 offered by the Department of Corrections. 29 certified public accounting firm to establish a state inmate cost 30 per day for a comparable state facility. The state inmate cost 31 per day shall be certified annually. The certified cost shall be 32 used as the basis for measuring the validity of the ten percent 33 (10%) savings of the contractor costs.

34 (4) The rates and benefits for correctional services shall
35 be negotiated based upon American Correction Association
36 standards, state law and court orders.

(5) The contract shall require that the private correctional 37 facility shall purchase prison clothing, beds and bedding by bid 38 39 and if the nonprofit Mississippi Prison Industries Corporation submits a competitive bid that is not greater than five percent 40 (5%) above the lowest and best bid then the contract shall be 41 awarded to the Mississippi Prison Industries Corporation. 42 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 43 and after July 1, 2002. 44
