AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-59-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO PROVIDE THAT AN AMBULANCE SERVICE LICENSEE SHALL NOT BE 2 REQUIRED TO CONFORM WITH LOCAL LAWS OR REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO ANY AGENCY OR BRANCH OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT; 3 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 41-59-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 9 41-59-21. (1) The issuance of a license shall not be construed to authorize any person, firm, corporation or 10 association to provide ambulance services or to operate any 11 ambulance not in conformity with any ordinance or regulation 12 13 enacted by any county, municipality or special purpose district or 14 authority. (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), any 15 person, firm, corporation or association licensed by the State of 16 Mississippi to provide ambulance services or to operate an 17 ambulance shall not be required to obtain or act in conformity 18 19 with any ordinance or regulation enacted by any county, municipality or special purpose district or authority to provide 20 services to any agency or branch of the United States government. 21 22 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23 and after its passage.
