SENATE BILL NO. 2971

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-59-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO PROVIDE THAT AN AMBULANCE SERVICE LICENSEE SHALL NOT BE
3 REQUIRED TO CONFORM WITH LOCAL LAWS OR REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE
4 SERVICES TO ANY AGENCY OR BRANCH OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT;
5 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** Section 41-59-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
8 amended as follows:

9 41-59-21. (1) The issuance of a license shall not be
10 construed to authorize any person, firm, corporation or
11 association to provide ambulance services or to operate any
12 ambulance not in conformity with any ordinance or regulation
13 enacted by any county, municipality or special purpose district or
14 authority.

15 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), any
16 person, firm, corporation or association licensed by the State of
17 Mississippi to provide ambulance services or to operate an
18 ambulance shall not be required to obtain or act in conformity
19 with any ordinance or regulation enacted by any county,
20 municipality or special purpose district or authority to provide
21 services to any agency or branch of the United States government.

22 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
23 and after its passage.
