SENATE BILL NO. 2985

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-44, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
TO REQUIRE DECALS ISSUED FOR DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE
TAGS OR PLATES TO IDENTIFY THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE MOTOR VEHICLE
IS REGISTERED; TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-31, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 27-19-44, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

8 amended as follows:

27-19-44. (1) (a) For any distinctive license tag or plate 9 authorized by the Legislature from and after July 1, 2000, the 10 requirements of this subsection must be met before the State Tax 11 Commission may prepare or issue any such license tag or plate. 12 The organization or other entity for which the Legislature 13 14 authorized the distinctive license tag or plate must submit proof satisfactory to the State Tax Commission that at least one hundred 15 (100) of such license tags or plates will be purchased and must 16 deposit with the commission an amount necessary to purchase one 17 hundred (100) of such license tags or plates. The organization or 18 other entity for which the Legislature authorized the distinctive 19 license tag or plate must satisfy the requirements of this 20 21 subsection (1) within two (2) years after the effective date of 22 the law authorizing the license tag or plate in order to permit 23 the license tag or plate to be prepared and issued.

24 (b) If the organization or other entity for which the 25 Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate meets 26 the requirements of <u>paragraph (a)</u> of this <u>sub</u>section, the State 27 Tax Commission shall prepare and issue the distinctive license tag 28 or plate. If the State Tax Commission prepares and issues a

distinctive license tag or plate for the organization or other entity, the commission shall review the number of such license tags or plates issued during the period for the license tag or plate series. If the number of distinctive license tags or plates falls below one hundred (100) in the last year of the series, the license tag or plate shall be discontinued at the end of the period for the series.

If a distinctive license tag or plate is 36 (C) discontinued under paragraph (b) of this subsection, the 37 organization or other entity for which the license tag or plate 38 39 was discontinued may prepare a distinctive license tag or plate decal. The distinctive license tag or plate decal shall be of 40 41 such size, color and design as may be agreed upon by the organization or other entity and the State Tax Commission. 42 However, the State Tax Commission shall have final approval of the 43 size, color and design of the decal. The distinctive license tag 44 45 or plate decals shall be prepared and sold by the organization or other entity, and the proceeds derived from the sale of such 46 decals shall be retained by the organization or other entity for 47 48 any use deemed appropriate by the organization or other entity. (2) From and after July 1, 2002, one of the decals issued 49 50 for all distinctive license tags or plates shall identify the

51 <u>county in which the motor vehicle is registered.</u> The State Tax 52 <u>Commission shall prescribe the manner in which the county of</u> 53 <u>registration is identified on the decal.</u>

54 **SECTION 2.** Section 27-19-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 55 amended as follows:

56 27-19-31. (1) The State Tax Commission is authorized and 57 directed to establish and maintain a vehicle registration renewal 58 system whereby the license tag attached upon a motor vehicle or 59 trailer may be issued for five (5) years with the approval of the 60 License Tag Commission, except for motor vehicles registered in 61 excess of ten thousand (10,000) pounds gross vehicle weight, and

motor vehicles in a fleet registered under Section 27-19-66, 62 63 apportioned vehicles, rental and commercial trailers and buses, which shall be issued for a period of time determined by the State 64 65 Tax Commission. During each intervening year of the period for 66 which license tags are issued, the State Tax Commission shall 67 issue up to two (2) license decals, in lieu of the license tags, which will specify the month and year in which the license tag 68 shall expire. Motor vehicles in a corporate fleet registered 69 under Section 27-19-66, shall not be issued decals specifying the 70 71 month and year of expiration.

Any series of tags may be cancelled by the commissioner with the approval of the License Tag Commission and a new series of tags issued.

(2) The license decals issued in lieu of the license tags 75 shall indicate the month and the last two (2) figures of the year 76 for which such license shall expire, and these decals shall be 77 color coded so that it shall be possible to distinguish the year 78 79 and the month for which such decals shall expire. One (1) of the license decals issued for distinctive license tags or plates shall 80 81 also indicate the county of registration of the motor vehicle as provided for in Section 27-19-44(2). The license decals shall be 82 83 attached to the license tag of the motor vehicle or trailer, and when so attached shall be deemed to be the license tag for the 84 ensuing registration year. The month decal shall be attached in 85 86 an upright position in the lower left corner of the license tag, and the year decal shall be attached in an upright position in the 87 88 lower right corner of the license tag. Decals specifying the month and year of expiration shall not be required to be attached 89 to license tags on motor vehicles in a corporate fleet registered 90 under Section 27-19-66. 91

92 Except as otherwise provided in this paragraph, the 93 registration year shall be a period of one (1) year commencing on 94 the first day of the month following the month in which the

vehicle was acquired. Beginning October 1, 1982, original 95 registrations of motor vehicles, except motor vehicles registered 96 in excess of ten thousand (10,000) pounds gross vehicle weight, 97 98 apportioned vehicles and buses, may be made and shall be prorated 99 for a period of from six (6) to eleven (11) months according to regulations established by the State Tax Commission to reduce a 100 disproportionate number of registrations for a particular month. 101 102 Beginning July 1, 1995, original registrations and renewal 103 registrations of motor vehicles in corporate fleets registered under Section 27-19-66, shall be prorated according to regulations 104 105 established by the State Tax Commission so as to cause the registration of such fleet motor vehicles to coincide with the 106 107 anniversary month for corporate fleets established by the State 108 Tax Commission. Where a vehicle is registered for a period less than twelve (12) months, the anniversary month shall be the month 109 110 of the expiration of the original license tag.

Beginning July 1, 1996, original registrations and renewal 111 112 registrations of motor vehicles in individual fleets registered under Section 27-19-66 shall be prorated according to regulations 113 114 established by the State Tax Commission so as to cause the registration of such fleet motor vehicles to coincide with the 115 116 anniversary month for individual fleets established by the county 117 tax collector. Where a vehicle is registered for a period less than twelve (12) months, the anniversary month shall be the month 118 119 of the expiration of the original license tag.

The State Tax Commission, with the approval of the License 120 121 Tag Commission, shall so specify the area or areas on the license tag where the license decals shall be attached. The number of the 122 license tag shall be written across its face, and the number of 123 124 the tag shall represent the registration number; and upon all the tags for private passenger vehicles the word "MISSISSIPPI" shall 125 126 be written across the top of the tag in capital letters sufficiently large to be easily read, but upon all other tags such 127

word may be abbreviated. The number of the license tag shall not 128 exceed seven (7) letters, numbers or a combination of such letters 129 and numbers. Also, on all tags sold and issued, an appropriate 130 131 place will be provided thereon to place license decals indicating 132 the expiration date of the tag. For the purposes of this section and Section 27-19-32, Mississippi Code of 1972, the term "decal," 133 134 "decals" or "license decal" shall mean a tab, sticker or other similar device attached to a license tag which validates same for 135 a stated period of time. One (1) license tag and up to two (2) 136 license decals shall be furnished for all vehicles and shall be 137 138 fastened immovably twelve (12) inches or more above the ground, at the rear of the vehicle under or over the rear light, with the 139 140 number in upright position so that it will be plainly visible and legible at all times, and at night at a distance of sixty (60) 141 feet. In the case of tractors or other motor vehicles drawing or 142 pulling trailers, semitrailers or farm implements, the tag shall 143 be fastened upon such vehicle twelve (12) inches or more above the 144 145 ground, upon the front or back of such vehicle, with the number in an upright position. Such license plate, all characters and any 146 147 legally affixed decals shall not be defaced, covered or obstructed from view by any object, decal, sticker, paint, marking or license 148 149 plate bracket or holder. Any person who defaces, covers or 150 obstructs any portion of a license tag with any sticker, decoration, paint, marking, license plate bracket or holder or any 151 152 other thing or device, in such a manner that the characters and any legally affixed decals on the tag cannot be read, shall be 153 154 guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by 155 a fine of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). However, it 156 shall not be unlawful for the county name to be partially or 157 completely obstructed from view by any object, decal, sticker or license plate bracket or holder. Unless the license tag with 158 159 current decals is fastened to the vehicle as herein provided, the 160 said vehicle shall be regarded as operating without a license tag,

S. B. No. 2985 02/SS26/R727 PAGE 5 161 and the owner or operator shall be liable for the penalties herein 162 provided.

In addition to the above requirements, license tags for private passenger vehicles shall have a county designation thereon referencing the name of the county in which such vehicle is registered.

Law enforcement officers of this state shall remove from a 167 168 motor vehicle or trailer any license tag and/or decals which are so defaced that proper identification cannot be reasonably made. 169 The officer shall issue to the driver of such vehicle a tag permit 170 which shall be valid for a period of five (5) days. Each person 171 receiving such tag permit shall purchase, within five (5) days 172 173 from the date of the issuance of the permit, a new tag and/or 174 decals for the fee set forth in Section 27-19-37, Mississippi Code 175 of 1972, for a substitute tag.

Any person who has a license tag or decals on a vehicle which 176 may be so defaced that proper identification cannot be reasonably 177 178 made may remove such and purchase another license tag and/or decals for the same fee required for a substitute tag. 179 If any 180 license tag shall deteriorate due to age so that identification cannot be reasonably made, the owner may surrender such tag to the 181 182 issuing authority and be issued a new tag and like decals at no 183 cost.

(3) The State Tax Commission is authorized to promulgate appropriate rules and regulations to govern the use and display of license decals and to publish a summary thereof which shall be available to state officials and the public upon request.

188 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 189 and after July 1, 2002.
