SENATE BILL NO. 3005

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR 1 VEHICLE LICENSE TAGS FOR PERSONS SERVING AS DULY ELECTED 2 CONSTABLES; TO PROVIDE FOR A FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH TAGS; 3 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is serving 6 as a duly elected constable, upon payment of the road and bridge 7 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 8 9 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 10 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 11 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor 12 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a 13 constable. The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of 14 such color and design as designated by the State Tax Commission, 15 shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be 16 17 necessary to distinguish each license tag; provided, however, that such tag shall have the word "constable" on it and shall display 18 the name of the county in which the applicant serves as constable. 19 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 20 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 21 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for such 22 distinctive license tags shall present to the issuing official 23 proof that they are serving as a constable in the county. The 24 application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of 25 this section, less three percent (3%) thereof to be retained by 26 the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission 27 28 on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.

Any person applying for a distinctive license tag under 31 (3) 32 this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount of 33 Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) for each distinctive license tag applied for under this section which shall be in addition to all 34 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 35 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 36 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 37 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 38 39 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 40 41 license taq. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license tag, or if the owner retires or resigns from or otherwise 42 vacates the office of constable, he must surrender it to the local 43 county tax collector. 44

(4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
State Treasury. At the end of each month, the State Tax
Commission shall certify the total fees collected under this
section from the issuance of distinctive license tags to the State
Treasurer who shall distribute such collections as follows:

(a) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

(b) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
section shall be deposited into the State Highway Fund to be
expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
reconstruction of highways.

59 (c) The remainder shall be deposited into the State60 General Fund.

A regular license tag must be properly displayed as (5) 61 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 62 The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 63 this section. 64 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 65 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 66 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 67 68 tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license (6) 69 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 70 71 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37, Mississippi Code of 1972. The fee for a 72 replacement distinctive license tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). 73 The tax collector receiving such application and affidavit shall 74 75 be entitled to retain and deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag and 76 the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds 77 78 from the sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under this section. 79

80 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 81 and after July 1, 2002.
