SENATE BILL NO. 3027

AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 45-15-17, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1 1972, TO PROVIDE FOR THE DUTY OF CARE WITH RESPECT TO THE 2 3 PLACEMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITY FACILITIES ON OR ADJACENT TO 4 RIGHTS-OF-WAY OF STATE HIGHWAYS AND OTHER ROADS, STREETS AND BRIDGES; TO PROVIDE FOR THE DUTY OF CARE OF PROPERTY OWNERS WHO 5 ARE NOT THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A PUBLIC UTILITY; TO DEFINE 6 7 PUBLIC UTILITY FACILITIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 9 10 45-15-17, Mississippi Code of 1972: 45-15-17. (1) The duty of care owed to the public by the 11 owners and/or operators of public utility facilities located 12

13 adjacent to a highway, road, street or bridge in this state shall 14 be satisfied when:

(a) With respect to state highways, the public utility
facilities comply with the provisions of the applicable edition of
the National Electrical Safety Code of structure placement
relative to roadways;

(b) With respect to roads, streets and bridges not part of the state highway system, the public utility facilities located in public right-of-way comply with the provisions of the applicable edition of the National Electrical Safety Code for structure placement relative to roadways;

(c) With respect to roads, streets and bridges not part
of the state highway system, the public utility facilities located
on private property comply with provisions of the applicable
edition of the National Electrical Safety Code for structure
placement relative to roadways;

With respect to structures, appurtenances, 29 (d) equipment or appliances whose placement or installation is not 30 subject to the provisions of the National Electric Safety Code, 31 32 the public utility facilities comply with the provisions of the 33 standards in effect at the time such structure, appurtenance, equipment or appliance is placed, installed or located adjacent to 34 any highway, road, street or bridge in this state, whether or not 35 a part of the state highway system. 36

37 (2) (a) The owner of a road, street, highway or bridge, 38 which is not itself the owner or operator of a public utility, 39 shall owe no duty to the public regarding or relating to the 40 placement or location of any public utility facilities within or 41 appurtenant to the right-of-way of such road, street, highway or 42 bridge.

(b) The owner of private property, which is not itself the owner or operator of a public utility, shall owe no duty to the public regarding or relating to the placement or location of any public utility facilities on or appurtenant to such private property.

48 (3) For the purpose of this section, "public utility
49 facilities" means pipes, mains, conduits, cables, wires, towers,
50 poles and other structures, equipment or appliances, whether
51 publicly or privately owned, installed or placed adjacent to any
52 roadway by an owner or operator of a public utility facility.
53 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be codified as
54 Section 45-15-17, Mississippi Code of 1972.

55 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 56 and after its passage.
