## SENATE BILL NO. 3123

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 899, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1988, AS AMENDED, TO INCREASE TO \$750.00 THE AMOUNT OF THE MINIMUM MONTHLY BENEFITS AUTHORIZED FOR PERSONS RECEIVING BENEFITS UNDER 3 THE DISABILITY AND RELIEF FUND FOR FIREMEN AND POLICEMEN OF THE CITY OF VICKSBURG; TO AMEND CHAPTER 911, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2000, TO PROVIDE THAT THE ADDITIONAL COST OF LIVING PAYMENT TO 6 RETIRED MEMBERS OF THE DISABILITY AND RELIEF FUND FOR FIREMEN AND 7 POLICEMEN OF THE CITY OF VICKSBURG SHALL BE EQUAL TO 2-1/2% OF THE 8 ANNUAL RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR EACH FULL FISCAL YEAR OF 9 RETIREMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 10

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 12 SECTION 1. Chapter 899, Local and Private Laws of 1988, as
- 13 amended by Chapter 857, Local and Private Laws of 1992, as amended
- 14 by Chapter 904, Local and Private Laws of 2000, is amended as
- 15 follows:
- 16 Section 1. The governing authorities of the City of
- 17 Vicksburg, Mississippi, are authorized, in their discretion, to
- 18 appropriate and transfer annually from the general fund of the
- 19 city to the Disability and Relief Fund for Firemen and Policemen
- 20 of the city sufficient additional funds to provide for the payment
- 21 of minimum monthly benefits of not less than Seven Hundred Fifty
- 22 Dollars (\$750.00) per month to all persons now or hereafter
- 23 entitled to receive benefits under any provision of Section
- 24 21-29-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, by virtue of service
- 25 as a member of the fire and/or police department of the City of
- 26 Vicksburg. When the governing authorities of the City of
- 27 Vicksburg, by resolution duly adopted and entered on their
- 28 minutes, have transferred sufficient additional funds to fund such
- 29 minimum monthly benefits, as determined by the Board of Trustees
- 30 of the Public Employees' Retirement System of Mississippi, then

31 the board of trustees shall pay such minimum monthly payments to

32 the persons authorized and entitled to receive such benefits.

33 SECTION 2. Chapter 911, Local and Private Laws of 1992, is

34 amended as follows:

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35 Section 1. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2)

36 of this section, the governing authorities of the City of

37 Vicksburg, Mississippi, are authorized, in their discretion, to

38 establish the payment of one (1) additional payment each year from

39 monies accumulated in the Disability and Relief Fund for Firemen

40 and Policemen of the city to retired members of such disability

41 and relief fund, or beneficiaries thereof, who on December 1 of

each year are receiving a retirement allowance under Article 3,

43 Chapter 29, Title 21, Mississippi Code of 1972. The amount of the

44 payment shall be equal to \* \* \* two and one-half percent (2-1/2%)

45 of the annual retirement allowance for each full fiscal year after

June 30, 1991, that the retired member or beneficiary has actually

47 drawn retirement payments from the date of retirement.

48 (2) Payment of the additional payments authorized under

subsection (1) of this section shall not be established unless the

Disability and Relief Fund for Firemen and Policemen of the City

of Vicksburg is actuarially sound, as shown by the most recent

52 actuarial study required by Section 21-29-119, Mississippi Code of

53 1972, and unless the fund will remain actuarially sound if the

54 additional payments authorized under subsection (1) of this

55 section are made, as shown by a certified statement from the

56 actuarial firm that prepared the most recent actuarial study.

57 (3) After the governing authorities of the City of

58 Vicksburg have adopted a resolution to establish the additional

59 payments authorized under subsection (1) of this section and the

60 advisory board provided for in Section 21-29-105, Mississippi Code

of 1972, has adopted a resolution supporting the establishment of

62 the additional payments, and after the Board of Trustees of the

63 Public Employees' Retirement System has received these resolutions

- 64 and received the most recent actuarial study of the disability and
- 65 relief fund and the certified statement from the actuarial firm
- 66 that the fund will remain actuarially sound if the additional
- 67 payments are made, then the board of trustees shall make the
- 68 payments directly to the persons authorized and entitled to
- 69 receive the payments.
- 70 (4) Persons eligible to receive the payments authorized
- 71 under this section shall receive such payments in one (1)
- 72 additional payment, except that any such person may elect by an
- 73 irrevocable agreement on a form prescribed by the Board of
- 74 Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System to receive
- 75 such payments in not less than equal monthly installments not to
- 76 exceed six (6) months during the remaining months of the current
- 77 fiscal year. In the event of death of a person or a beneficiary
- 78 thereof receiving monthly benefits, any remaining amounts shall be
- 79 paid in a lump sum to the designated beneficiary.
- 80 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 81 and after its passage.
