SENATE BILL NO. 3123 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 899, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1988, 1 2 AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 857, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1992, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 904, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2000, TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF THE MINIMUM MONTHLY BENEFITS AUTHORIZED FOR 3 4 PERSONS RECEIVING BENEFITS UNDER THE DISABILITY AND RELIEF FUND 5 FOR FIREMEN AND POLICEMEN OF THE CITY OF VICKSBURG; TO AMEND 6 CHAPTER 911, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1992, TO PROVIDE THAT THE 7 ADDITIONAL ANNUAL PAYMENT MADE TO RETIRED MEMBERS OF THE DISABILITY AND RELIEF FUND FOR FIREMEN AND POLICEMEN OF THE CITY 8 9 10 OF VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI, SHALL BE EQUAL TO TWO AND ONE-HALF PERCENT OF THE ANNUAL RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR EACH FULL FISCAL 11 YEAR AFTER JUNE 30, 2001, THAT THE RETIRED MEMBER OR BENEFICIARY 12 HAS ACTUALLY DRAWN RETIREMENT BENEFITS FROM THE DATE OF 13 RETIREMENT; TO PROVIDE THAT THE ADDITIONAL ANNUAL PAYMENTS 14 AUTHORIZED BY THIS ACT SHALL NOT BE ESTABLISHED UNLESS THE 15 16 DISABILITY AND RELIEF FUND CURRENTLY IS ACTUARIALLY SOUND AND WILL REMAIN ACTUARIALLY SOUND IF THE ADDITIONAL ANNUAL PAYMENTS ARE 17 18 MADE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Chapter 899, Local and Private Laws of 1988, as amended by Chapter 857, Local and Private Laws of 1992, is amended as follows:

Section 1. The governing authorities of the City of 23 Vicksburg, Mississippi, may, in their discretion, \* \* \* 24 appropriate and transfer annually from the general fund of the 25 city to the Disability and Relief Fund for Firemen and Policemen 26 of the city sufficient additional funds to provide for the payment 27 of minimum monthly benefits of not less than Seven Hundred Fifty 28 Dollars (\$750.00) per month to all persons now or hereafter 29 entitled to receive benefits under any provision of Section 30 21-29-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, by virtue of service 31 as a member of the fire and/or police department of the City of 32 33 Vicksburg. When the governing authorities of the City of Vicksburg, by resolution duly adopted and entered on their 34 minutes, have transferred sufficient additional funds to fund such 35 N1/2S. B. 36 minimum monthly benefits, as determined by the Board of Trustees 37 of the Public Employees' Retirement System of Mississippi, then 38 the board of trustees shall pay such minimum monthly payments to 39 the persons authorized and entitled to receive such benefits.

40 **SECTION 2.** Chapter 911, Local and Private Laws of 1992, is 41 amended as follows:

Subject to the provisions of subsection (2) 42 Section 1. (1) of this section, the governing authorities of the City of 43 Vicksburg, Mississippi, are authorized, in their discretion, to 44 establish the payment of one (1) additional payment each year from 45 46 monies accumulated in the Disability and Relief Fund for Firemen and Policemen of the city to retired members of such disability 47 and relief fund, or beneficiaries thereof, who on December 1 of 48 49 each year are receiving a retirement allowance under Article 3, Chapter 29, Title 21, Mississippi Code of 1972. The amount of the 50 payment shall be equal to (a) the annual percentage change in each 51 fiscal year of the Consumer Price Index set by the United States 52 53 government, not to exceed two and one-half percent (2-1/2%) of the annual retirement allowance for each full fiscal year after June 54 30, 1991, and through June 30, 2001, that the retired member or 55 beneficiary has actually drawn retirement payments from the date 56 57 of retirement, and (b) two and one-half percent (2-1/2%) of the annual retirement allowance for each full fiscal year after June 58 30, 2001, that the retired member or beneficiary has actually 59 60 drawn retirement benefits from the date of retirement.

(2) Payment of the additional payments authorized under subsection (1) of this section shall not be established unless the Disability and Relief Fund for Firemen and Policemen of the City of Vicksburg is actuarially sound, as shown by the most recent actuarial study required by Section 21-29-119, Mississippi Code of 1972, and unless the fund will remain actuarially sound if the additional payments authorized under subsection (1) of this

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section are made, as shown by a certified statement from theactuarial firm that prepared the most recent actuarial study.

After the governing authorities of the City of Vicksburg 70 (3) 71 have adopted a resolution to establish the additional payments 72 authorized under subsection (1) of this section and the advisory board provided for in Section 21-29-105, Mississippi Code of 1972, 73 has adopted a resolution supporting the establishment of the 74 additional payments, and after the Board of Trustees of the Public 75 Employees' Retirement System has received these resolutions and 76 received the most recent actuarial study of the disability and 77 78 relief fund and the certified statement from the actuarial firm that the fund will remain actuarially sound if the additional 79 80 payments are made, then the board of trustees shall make the payments directly to the persons authorized and entitled to 81 receive the payments. 82

Persons eligible to receive the payments authorized 83 (4)under this section shall receive such payments in one (1) 84 additional payment, except that any such person may elect by an 85 irrevocable agreement on a form prescribed by the Board of 86 87 Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System to receive such payments in not less than equal monthly installments not to 88 89 exceed six (6) months during the remaining months of the current fiscal year. In the event of death of a person or a beneficiary 90 thereof receiving monthly benefits, any remaining amounts shall be 91 paid in a lump sum to the designated beneficiary. 92

93 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 94 and after its passage.
