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| 3 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: |
| 4 | SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as |
| 5 | may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the |
| 6 | State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the |
| 7 | expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration for the |
| 8 | fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002 and ending June 30, 2003 |
| 9 | \$ 12,947,671.00. |
| 10 | SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 11 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State |
| 12 | Treasury to the credit of the Department of Finance and |
| 13 | Administration for the purpose of defraying the expenses incurred |
| 14 | in the operation of the various offices of the department for the |
| 15 | fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002 and ending June 30, 2003 |
| 16 | \$ 16,481,063.00. |
| 17 | SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions |
| 18 | of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: |

         SECTION 7. Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable
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    Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a
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pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment

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component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars 61 62 (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 63 64 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 65 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 66 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 67 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 68 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 69 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 70 71 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, for the period of July 1, 2002, through December 31, 2002, and 72 January 1, 2003, through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 73 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 74 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 75 76 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 77 78 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semiannual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 79 80 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 81 82 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 83 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 84 85 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 86 87 the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers within each specific budget or escalations 88 shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and 89 procedures established by law. 90

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

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- 93 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 94 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 95 **SECTION 8.** The Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property
- 96 Management of the Office of General Services is hereby expressly
- 97 authorized and empowered to receive, budget and expend any state,

- 117 Hundred Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$165,000.00) is authorized to
- 118 be spent out of the Local Disaster Loan Fund No. 3144 by the
- 119 Department of Finance and Administration for the purpose of
- 120 defraying the cost of the Air Transport Services.
- 121 SECTION 11. The Office of Capitol Facilities, Department of
- 122 Finance and Administration, is hereby expressly authorized and
- 123 empowered to receive funds from state agencies for the rent of
- 124 office space in the Eldon Bolton Office Building in Biloxi,
- 125 Mississippi, and the State Service Center in Hattiesburg,

Mississippi. The Office of Capitol Facilities is further 126 authorized and empowered to budget and expend any such funds 127 received to operate and maintain, and up to Five Dollars (\$5.00) 128 129 per square foot of rental receipts to finish tenant space, in the 130 Eldon Bolton Office Building in Biloxi, Mississippi, and the State 131 Service Center in Hattiesburg, Mississippi, as state office buildings. Monies received for rent of such office space are to 132 be deposited in a special fund in the State Treasury. Any funds 133 on hand at the end of the fiscal year shall lapse into the State 134 General Fund. 135 136 SECTION 12. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, an amount not less than One Million Four Hundred Seventy-two 137 Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$1,472,260.00) shall be used 138 to defray the expenses of the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real 139 Property Management. 140 SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 141 Department of Finance and Administration shall maintain complete 142 143 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 144 145 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2002. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 146 147 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2004 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 148 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 149 150 provided during the Fiscal Year 2003 budget request process. SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 151 152 Department of Finance and Administration is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred 153 Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), from any source in accordance with 154 155 rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 156 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 157 federal funds.

| 178 | Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the |
| 179 | provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended |

| 181 | SECTION 17. It is the intention of the Legislature that the |
| 182 | Department of Finance and Administration may utilize funds |
| 183 | appropriated under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2, and |
| 184 | allocated in Section 12, to hire architects and engineers as |
| 185 | required and approved by the State Personnel Board. Such |
| 186 | adjustment shall not increase the projected annual cost to fully |

SECTION 19. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 20. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002.

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
