Such funds shall be escalated in accordance with 95 the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 96 97 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 98 federal funds. SECTION 10. Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable 99 Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a 100 pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment 101 102 component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003. 103 104 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 105 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 106 107 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 108 109 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 121 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 122 123 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 124 125 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 126

SECTION 11.
