## SENATE BILL NO. 3145

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF 1 STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF 2 THE CONSOLIDATED OPERATION OF THE EDUCATION AND RESEARCH CENTER, 3 THE UNIVERSITY RESEARCH CENTER AND MARIS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees 8 9 of State Institutions of Higher Learning, who is assigned custody and management of the center: (1) to defray the expenses of 10 operating and maintaining the Education and Research Center of 11 Mississippi and the Mississippi Automated Resource Information 12 System (MARIS), including, but not limited to, the maintenance of 13 said buildings and grounds and expenses for fuel, water, 14 electricity, telephones, supplies and salaries for personnel 15 necessary therefor; and (2) to be used for the support and 16 maintenance of the University Research Center for the fiscal year 17 beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003 . . . . . . . . . 18 .....\$ 2,969,963.00. 19 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 20 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 21 funds which are collected by or otherwise become available and 22 funds available from building use charge for the following 23 purposes: (1) to defray the expenses of operating and maintaining 24 the Education and Research Center of Mississippi and the 25 26 Mississippi Automated Resource Information System (MARIS), including, but not limited to, the maintenance of said buildings 27 and grounds, and expenses for fuel, water, electricity, 28 S. 29 telephones, supplies and salaries for personnel necessary 30 therefor; and (2) to be used for the support and maintenance of the University Research Center for the fiscal year beginning 31 July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... \$ 1,606,344.00. 32 33 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 34 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 35 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. Any 36 transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the 37 terms, conditions and procedures established by law. 38

39 SECTION 3. Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and 40 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be 41 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of 42 Mississippi and Section 25-4-103, Mississippi Code of 1972.

43 SECTION 4. All fees charged and collected by the University 44 Research Center for services provided by the Mississippi Automated 45 Resource Information System (MARIS) shall be deposited in a 46 special fund to be known as the "Mississippi Automated Resource 47 Information System (MARIS) Revolving Fund." All monies in the 48 revolving fund shall be used by MARIS exclusively for the support 49 of MARIS projects and activities.

50 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 51 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2004 shall be submitted to 52 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 53 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 54 during the Fiscal Year 2003 budget request process.

55 SECTION 6. Of the funds authorized for expenditure in 56 Section 2, Four Hundred Seven Thousand Nine Hundred 57 Forty-one Dollars (\$407,941.00) shall be derived from 58 the Education Enhancement Fund from funds deposited pursuant to

59 Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

60 **SECTION 7.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 61 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

No. 3145 02/SS05/A254 PAGE 2 62 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 63 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 64 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 65 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 66 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 67 and after July 1, 2002.
